

ERIC LUCAS JUNIOR MATCHPLAY CHAMPIONSHIPS - 2018

Wednesday 4th April 2018 and Friday 6th April 2018 at THE FLINDERS GOLF CLUB

Entry in the ERIC LUCAS JUNIOR MATCHPLAY CHAMPIONSHIPS is restricted to **financial amateur male and female junior members**, with golf playing rights of GPV Member Clubs and must be **under 19 years** on the day of the event.

WEDNESDAY 4th APRIL - AM ROUNDS ONLY

STROKE ROUND (Qualifying Round) - All players (male and female) will play 18 holes of stroke play in the morning commencing at **8.00 am**.

From the Qualifying Round results the following finals will take place on Friday 6th April.

FRIDAY 6th APRIL - AM and PM ROUNDS

18 HOLE MATCHPLAY FINAL FORMAT

MATCHPLAY SEMI-FINAL - AM

18 hole Matchplay Semi-Final hitting off at **8.00 am**.

BOYS:

4 Players with the best Gross Scores & 4 players with the best Nett scores to qualify for the matchplay Semi-Final.

GIRLS: (depending on numbers entered) 4 Players with the best Gross Scores & 4 players with the best Nett scores to qualify for the matchplay Semi-Final.

MATCHPLAY FINAL - PM

18 hole Matchplay Final hitting off at **1.00 pm**.

BOYS:

2 Winning Players from Gross Semi-Final and 2 players from Nett Semi-Final to play off in the final.

GIRLS:

2 Winning Players from Gross Semi-Final and 2 players from Nett Semi-Final to play off in the final.

PRIZES

Perpetual Trophy and prize for District Junior Matchplay Champions.

Prizes for Net Matchplay Champions and Qualifiers.

GOLF PENINSULA VIC ERIC LUCAS SHIELD COMPETITION CONDITIONS

1. The GPV Executive in collaboration with the host club (hereinafter referred to as the "committee") will be responsible for the management of the event.

2. Entry in the ERIC LUCAS JUNIOR MATCHPLAY CHAMPIONSHIPS is restricted to **financial amateur male and female members**, with golf playing rights, of GPV Member Clubs who must, if required by the Committee, be able to produce evidence of current handicap before being eligible to win a handicap competition.

3. Entries will be limited to approximately 52 players and the Committee shall decide, if considered necessary, by ballot, whose entry will be accepted.

4. The Rules of Golf, as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, shall apply, together with such local rules as are in force on the course over which the event takes place. In the event of any dispute that arises on any point or any protest, which must be made not later than ten minutes after the conclusion of play, the Committee whose decision shall be final shall resolve these matters. Such Committee should include an Accredited Rules official.

5. In the event of adverse weather conditions, or for any other reason, the Committee may either shorten the event or appoint another date and/or venue.

6. Competitors are required to report to the Starter not later than fifteen minutes before their hit off time. The Committee has the right to amend the draw or substitute for any player, or pair, who fail to report on time.

7. Within three days of the closure of entries the Committee shall conduct a draw ensuring, whenever possible, members of other clubs play with entrants from the host club and shall post copies of the draw, as required to entrants Member clubs. Should the field limit be exceeded on or by the closing date the larger handicap players shall be excluded, by ballot if equal, from the draw but entry fee shall be refunded.

8. Entrants traveling together shall be drawn, when possible, close together.

9. No competitor may win more than one individual trophy or prize except for perpetual trophies.

10. The winner of a tie in a handicap competition or of runner-up in scratch competitions shall be decided on a count-back system currently recommended by the A.G.U., except when two or more tie for the Championship events a play-off over holes 1, 16 and 18 will. Be used to decide a winner. In the event their still being a tie a sudden death play off over holes 1, 16, and 18 shall continue until a winner is decided.

11. Results shall be declared and presentations made as soon as possible after the conclusion play.

12. On the day of the event entrants shall be elected Honorary Members of the host club.

NOTE:

To be eligible to enter the ERIC LUCAS SHIELD a player must be under 19 years on the day of the event
