2018 SRIXON NSW MID AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITIONS

These are to be read in conjunction with the Golf NSW Standard Conditions for Events run By Golf NSW, the Golf NSW Code of Conduct and the Golf NSW Hard Card. Should a conflict occur between conditions, then the conditions outlined on the entry form take precedence.

1. Championship Procedure

1.1 **The Championship** will be played as follows:

The Championships: Stroke play over three rounds of 18 holes, at Bathurst Golf Club. At the conclusion of the second round of stroke play, a seeded draw will take place for round three. The entire field are expected to contest all three rounds and must play as drawn. There will be no opportunity for players to change or request tee times for round three. The leading player(s) at the end of this stroke play shall be the 2018 Men's NSW Mid Amateur Champion or 2018 Women's NSW Mid Amateur Champion. In the event of a tie, the winner will be determined by sudden death play-off. If insufficient time is available for a play-off, joint winners will be declared. All other ties shall be determined using the Golf Australia Countback System.

Club Teams Event – to be played in conjunction with the Championship. Teams will consist of 2 or 3 players from the same golf club. The aggregate of the best 2 nett scores each round for the 54 holes will count towards the team's total. Players will have the opportunity to submit their team after the close of entries. A player can be part of one team only.

Srixon Ball Challenge – The Srixon Ball Challenge will be played in conjunction with the Championship and decided by the best 54 hole nett score (men and women in separate competitions). To be eligible for the Srixon Ball Challenge a player **will receive a free dozen golf ball pack of their choice from Srixon** and must use this product for the duration of the Championship. The Men's and Women's Srixon Ball Challenge winners will then be entitled to a year's supply (6 dozen) of their Srixon golf ball of choice.

2. Championship Committee

- 2.1 The Championship Committee will comprise the Chair of the Golf NSW Golf Committee, Golf NSW General Manager – Golf or their appointees, plus other nominated persons.
- 2.2 In the absence of a full Championship Committee, such members that may be present at the time may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Committee.

3. Rules of Play

The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R&A Rules Limited, will apply, together with Golf NSW Hard Card (see condition 15), and any additional Local Rules as drawn up by the Championship Committee.

4. Entries

- 4.1 **Handicap:** Eligible players are amateurs whose Golf Australia Handicap (or overseas equivalent) does not exceed 12.4 (men) or 20.4 (women) strokes at the time of entry.
- 4.2 **Age:** Eligible players must be 30 years of age or over as at the first day of play.
- 4.3 **Entry Fee:** \$160 online and \$170 for all other forms of entry.
- 4.4 **Ballot:** In the event of entry applications exceeding the number of places available in the Championship, applications from those higher handicap competitors will be decided by a handicap ballot. Unsuccessful applicants will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur. Monies received from balloted entrants, who do not subsequently compete, will be refunded in entirety.
- 4.5 **Exemptions:** There are no exemptions for this Championship.
- 4.6 **Final Acceptance:** The decision of the Championship Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.
- 4.7 **Provisional Handicaps:** A player may enter with a Provisional Handicap, but will not be eligible to participate if their handicap is Provisional at the time of close of entries or on a day of play.

5. Motorised Transport

The specimen condition on pages 159-160 of the Rules of Golf is in effect.

Participants must walk at all times during a stipulated round unless permission to use motorised transport has been granted by the Committee. The Committee will grant permission if the player is able to supply documentation (medical certificate or letter from club official) which states that the player requires use of motorised transport for medical reasons. Applications for permission **MUST** be made at the time of entry. Player's must book carts with the host club as Golf NSW takes no responsibility for the availability of golf carts.

6. Practice

Practice rounds prior to the Championship are at the discretion of the host club.

7. Registration

Competitors **MUST** register 30 mins before their starting time on each day of play.

8. Pace of Play

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. See the Golf NSW Hard Card for Pace of Play conditions.

9. Prizes

Competitors may win only one prize. Prizes will be awarded based on value. If two prizes are of the same value, the scratch prize will take precedent over the nett prize.

10. Golf NSW Hard Card

The Golf NSW Hard Card will be in effect throughout this event.
