

SENIOR MEDAL

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. ELIGIBILITY

- Male amateur golfers who are 55 years of age or above as at 31/12/2018
- Maximum GA Handicap of 10.4
- 40 players from the Golf NSW Senior Order of Merit list as advised by Golf NSW
- Members of either Avondale, Bonnie Doon, Concord, Cromer, Elanora, Killara, Kogarah, Manly, Moore Park, N.S.W., Oatlands, Pennant Hills, Pymble, Royal Canberra, Royal Sydney, St Michaels, The Australian and The Lakes
- By special invitation

FORMAT

- Tiger Tees
- Stroke
- 18 holes
- 90 players only (may be increased at the discretion of match committee)
- · Shotgun start in threes

3. SPECIAL CONDITIONS

- Highest handicapped players may be balloted out
- A tie in the Senior Medal (Gross) will be decided by a countback
- A tie in the nett event will be decided by a countback
- Mobile phones are not permitted in the Clubhouse, its surrounds or on the course
- Short socks may be worn with tailored shorts, but must be plain white in colour and may display a golf club's logo
- Shirts must have collars and be worn inside trousers. Obvious commercial advertising on clothing, including headwear, is not permitted
- Pace of play Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group in front. Any group with a clear hole in front will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties
- Player's cards must be returned immediately after the round is completed. An administrator will generally be stationed outside the entrance to the sports shop to collect cards but if not, then please return cards to the shop counter. Any player's card which is not returned in a reasonable time after the round is completed will unfortunately result in that player's disqualification

4. CARTS

- Carts and scooters are allowed for those members who are on the list of Registered Users of Golf Carts.
- Players who are not on the Registered Users of Golf Carts must provide a Medical Certificate.
- Playing partners may not use the spare seat unless qualified to use a cart.

5. TROPHIES & PRIZES

- Prizes for the Senior Medal are to be presented at the conclusion of play for:
 - Senior Medal Winner: Perpetual Trophy, Senior Medal & Royal Sydney Sport Shop Voucher
 - Senior Medal Runner-Up: Royal Sydney Sport Shop Voucher
 - Nett Winner: Royal Sydney Sport Shop Voucher
 - Nett Runner-Up: Royal Sydney Sport Shop Voucher
 - 65+ years Scratch Winner: Royal Sydney Sport Shop Voucher

Note: An individual player is eligible to accept more than one prize

6. ENTRY

- Invitations sent to top 40 players on previous years GNSW Senior Order of Merit
- Entry by entry sheet in Men's Locker Room for Royal Sydney Members
- Entries circulated to eligible clubs
- Entries close two weeks prior to the event
- Late entries are accepted if draw allows
- A copy of the draw to be sent to each club upon completion
- Entry Fee: \$60.00 payable on the day
