#### **ENTRY**

Each Player must enter the May Week Tournament by completing the entry details via <a href="www.mitournament.com">www.mitournament.com</a>, indicating the events entered and paying entry fees and other fees associated with social activities. Entries close on Friday 4<sup>th</sup> May at 5pm.

Motorised carts are available for hire by contacting the Pro Shop (8555 3271). Buggies may be left in the Club during the Tournament for \$2 per night and push buggies can be hired.

#### **EVENTS**

9 Hole Stableford on Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> May 2018 9.00am – 3.00pm Tee times.

Welcome function - Tuesday 15<sup>th</sup> May at 5.00pm which is complimentary (finger food and Serrafino wine tasting).

Championship events – Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> May.

Presentation Dinner Thursday 6.00pm for 6.30pm including welcome drink.

18 Hole Foursomes and express presentation lunch on Friday 18<sup>th</sup> May 2018.

#### THE CHAMPIONSHIP EVENTS

The Championship comprises the following events played over Wednesday 16<sup>th</sup> May and Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> May, 2018.

A & B Grade - 36 Hole Stroke Championship - Gross

A & B Grade - 36 Hole Handicap Stroke - Net

A & B Grade - 18 Hole Handicap Stroke on each day

C Grade - 36 Hole Stableford Championship

C Grade - 18 Hole Stableford on each day

No single day entries will be accepted.

There will be a two-tee start (1<sup>st</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup>) on each day, in handicap groups. Players will alternate early and late stat over the two days.

The draw for each event and championship day will be published at <a href="www.southlakesgolf.com.au">www.southlakesgolf.com.au</a> from Friday 11th May 2018. It is the player's responsibility to be aware of their tee times. Each player must collect their scorecard and report to the Starter at least 20 minutes before their tee time.

### MAY WEEK 2018 - CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- 1. The Championship events in the May Week Tournament will be played in 3 grades (A, B Stroke & C Stableford), over 36 holes on 16<sup>th</sup> & 17<sup>th</sup> May 2018. Grades are dependent on entries received. Your handicap on the first day of championship play will determine your Grade and will be fixed for the two day nett and Stableford events.
- 2. Other events include a 9 hole Stableford competition 15<sup>th</sup> May and an 18 hole foursomes competition on 18<sup>th</sup> May.
- 3. This event is to be conducted under Golf SA "Codes of Conduct". This includes the following restrictions:
  - a. Consuming any alcohol or a prohibited substance under the Golf Australia Doping Policy during the course of any round played in a competition.
  - b. Smoking cigarettes, cigars of the like during the course of any round played in a competition.
- 4. Play will be from the Red Tees.
- 5. The maximum field for each day of the Championship is 240 entries.
- 6. In the event of a tie for placings, a countback will apply.
- 7. The use of a motorised cart is permitted.
- 8. If a player arrives at the starting tee, ready to play, within 5 minutes after the starting time, the penalty or failure to start on time is **loss of 2 strokes at the first hole.** Otherwise the penalty for breach of this rule is **disqualification.** (Rule 6.3).
- 9. The Tournament Match Committee will determine playing arrangements (including calling a suspension/cancellation of play where necessary) and will umpire in the case of a dispute or protest.
- 10. A dispute/protest must be lodged, in writing, with the Match Committee in the clubhouse not later than 5 minutes after the conclusion of the day's play.
- 11. Players are expected to observe the dress standards and any other rules/requirements of the South Lakes Golf Club.
- 12. A presentation will be held at the conclusion of each day's play, except Thursday when daily and Championship prizes will be awarded at the Presentation Dinner. For the Championship events, first prizes take precedence over second prizes and gross prizes over net prizes.

#### Major prizes will include:

A & B Grade - 36 Hole Stroke Championship - Gross (Winner & Runner-up)

A & B Grade - 36 Hole Handicap Stroke - Net (Winner & Runner-up)

A & B Grade - 18 Hole Handicap Stroke on each day (Winner & Runner-up)

C Grade - 36 Hole Stableford Championship (Winner & Runner-up)

C Grade - 18 Hole Stableford on each day (Winner & Runner-up)
