CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- 1. Eligibility Open to Members of Liverpool Golf Club and Affiliated Clubs who have a GA handicap not exceeding 18.9 (JEAN DERRIN requirement This competition is open to female golfers who are members of an affiliated club, registered with GOLF NSW and have a GA Handicap of 14.4 and under)
- 2. Format
 - The Liverpool Cup shall be decided over 18 holes stroke play. i.
 - ii.In the event of a tie the winner will be decided by an 18 hole Playoff at an agreeable time to all parties concerned. In the event that an agreeable date cannot be reached the Match Committee will set down a date for play.

3. Championship Committee

- The Championship Committee shall comprise the Liverpool i. Captains, General Manager and other Members of the Liverpool Course & Competition Sub Committee.
- ii. The Championship Committee shall have the sole management and control of the Championship with full power at any time to alter or vary any of the conditions.
- iii. The Championship Committee's decision on matters affecting the Championship shall be final. Protests may be made in writing and submitted to the Championship Committee within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the day's play.

4. Rules of Play

i. The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R&A Rules Ltd shall apply together with Local Rules as drawn up by the Championship Committee.

5. Entries

- Entries must be made on the Official entry form or a copy i. thereof.
- ii. The entrance fee is AUD \$28 (includes GST).
- iii. Eligible players are male amateurs whose are members of an Affiliated Club whose handicap does not exceed 4.4 strokes and Members of the Club with a handicap not exceeding 10.1.
- iv. In the event of the number of applicants exceeding the places available in the championship, those applicants with the highest handicaps will be progressively removed from the competition. In the event of applicants with the same handicap being liable for removal there shall be a ballot amongst them to determine who will be removed. Ballot and removal of players will be conducted on player's GA handicap at the time of close of entries.
- Fully completed Entry Forms must be received at Liverpool v. Golf Club office prior to 5pm Thursday September 15, 2016 and must include the Entry Fee
- vi. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Championship Committee.
- vii. Entries will not be accepted by telephone.
- viii. Entrance fees will only be refunded before the close of entries. A medical certificate must accompany a request for withdrawal on medical grounds.
- 6. Starting Times
 - It is a condition of this Championship that, in the absence of i. circumstances that warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, if the player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five minutes of his starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes. The penalty for lateness beyond five minutes is

disqualification.

7. Registration

i. Competitors must register 30 minutes prior to their allotted tee time in the Pro Shop.

8. Pace of Play

i. Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced and a Pace of Play policy endorsed. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups, who infringe on the endorsed Pace of Play guidelines (available at the event). Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

9. By-Laws

i. Rules and Dress Regulations Entrants shall comply with the by-laws, rules and dress regulations of Liverpool Golf Club. Players and or Caddies not dressed appropriately will not be allowed access to the course. Dress regulations available at www.liverpoolgolf.com.au

10.Mobile Phones

The use of a mobile phone by a competitor or his caddie, i. whilst on the golf course during the event is distracting and inconsiderate. If the competitor or his caddie is in the possession of a mobile phone it should be turned off. If the phone rings this is deemed to be in use and the Committee may take disciplinary action against the offending player in accordance with the concluding paragraph of Section 1, Etiquette; Behaviour on the course.

11. Consumption of Alcohol

The consumption of alcohol by competitors and caddies on i. the course during a stipulated round is strictly prohibited. Penalty: Disqualification

12. Distance Measuring Devices

A player may obtain distance information using a device that i. measures distance only. (This includes mobile phones if used as a measuring device in silent mode only). If during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device that is designed to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. gradient, wind speed, temperature, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification, regardless of whether any such additional functions are actually used.

13. Suspension of Play

i. The following signals shall apply: SUSPENSION OF PLAY: (Note to Rule 6-8b) The Specimen Condition on pages 140-141 is in effect. All practice areas are closed during suspension for a dangerous situation (e.g. lightning) until the Committee has declared them open. Note: Suspension for a dangerous situation will be signaled by one prolonged airhorn note. All other types of suspension will be signaled by three consecutive air-horn notes, repeated. Resumption of play will be signaled by two short air-horn notes, repeated.

14. Practice

- i. Practice rounds prior to the Championship will NOT be made available at any time.
- 15. Prizes
 - i. Prizes will be awarded as follows:
 - a. Gross Score
 - i. Winner
 - ii. Runner Up b. Net Score

 - ii A player will only eligible for one trophy.
