#### **Draws & Results**

#### **Registration & Championship Office**

Players are required to register for the 2018 Queensland Women's Country Foursomes prior to their first round on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> May. The Championship Office and scoring area will be located in the clubhouse.

#### **Pull Carts**

Both clubs have a limited number of pull carts that will be available for hire – Local players are encouraged to bring their own pull carts.

#### **Motorised Carts**

Those players that have requested a golf cart are highlighted (Yellow – medical certificate. Blue – requested but with no certificate. Green – own cart). Due to limited availability, players who have not submitted a medical certificate may be required to walk. Players are required to pay for their carts each day at the Pro Shop prior to their round. NO MORE than 3 carts will be given out to a group. Players PLEASE NOTE: Neither club have the facilities to re-charge personal carts.

#### DISTANCE-MEASURING DEVICES

In this competition, the local rule allowing use of distance measuring devices will be in effect.

The Country Championship Presentation Night will be held on Wednesday night beginning at 7pm at the Magpies Sporting Club. Ticketing to enter the presentation function will be distributed at registration and throughout the Championship.
