Cancellations

Any individual that is unable to participate in the event **MUST** contact the Golf Victoria Office (8545 6200) prior to the day of play. On the day, please contact Jayden Zeinstra *04*27 *840 043*

Registration

Upon arrival at the course on, all competitors are requested to report to the registration desk in the main thoroughfare. All competitors are required to be at the appropriate tee NO LATER THAN 15 MINUTES prior to tee time.

Caddies

A player is **prohibited** from using a caddie during the stipulated round under the SSV General Conditions of Competition. Penalty: Two strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred; maximum penalty per round – Four strokes. In the event of a breach between the play of two holes, the penalty applies to the next hole. A player having a caddie in breach of this condition must immediately upon discovery that a breach has occurred ensure that they conform with this condition for the remainder of the stipulated round. Otherwise the player is disqualified.

Score Cards

All score cards are to be returned to the Golf Victoria scoring area in the respective Golf Clubhouses within 15 minutes of the completion of your round.

Dress Regulations

All players, spectators and teachers are required to adhere to the Host Clubs' dress regulations with particular reference to the following:

- Jean style pants, cargo pants, track suits, brief, baggy or below knee length shorts, t-shirts or collarless shirts are NOT PERMITTED either on the course or in the clubhouse.
- Short socks that are either predominantly white or compliment the colour of other clothing are permitted.
- Shirts must be tucked into pants

Advertising or display materials must not appear on clothing except for brand name logos

Any player not adhering to the Host Clubs' dress regulations will be prohibited from playing. Any caddie or guest not adhering to the Host Clubs' dress regulations will be requested to leave the course.

Club Course Regulations

Sand buckets **MUST** be taken and used by each player. Play will be from the tee markers as directed by the starter. Any player not complying with these requirements will be subject to action in accordance with the GV's Code of Conduct.

Slow Play

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding them. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.

Suspension of Play

In the event of heavy rain, lightning or for any other reason, the Championship Committee will be responsible for deciding whether to suspend play.

The signal for suspending play will be fifteen second blasts. The procedure when play is suspended is outlined under Rule 6-8b. When the course is ready for play, players will be advised to return to various locations. The signal for the resumption of play will be one long siren blast.

Lunches

Lunch vouchers will be provided to players at the card return at the completion of their round.

Pull Buggies & Practice Balls

Please note that pull buggies are available on the day of the Championship and will be supplied free of charge by The Metropolitan Golf Club. **Buggies must not be wheeled across the greens**. Buckets of practice balls are available for purchase from the golf shop for \$5.

Please note that the practice area will not be available for use after your round. This area is reserved for The Metropolitan GC members.

Trophy Presentation

All Championship trophies will be presented after the conclusion of the round on Friday 18 May. It would be appreciated if as many competitors as possible remain for the presentation to honour the respective trophy winners.

Prizes will be awarded for the following:

- ➢ Girls SSV Senior Secondary Championships 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.
- ▶ Boys SSV Senior Secondary Championships 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.

The SSV 17 Years & Under Boys and Girls State Team will also be announced at the presentations. This team will compete at The National School Championships in Coffs Harbour, NSW from August 26 - 31, 2018. These players will be required to stay for a team meeting after the team has been announced. The meeting will take approximately 30 minutes.
