

Cordina Consolidates at Flagstaff Hill

SA Seniors were again in the southern foothill suburbs of Adelaide at Flagstaff Hill Golf Club on Monday, 7th May on an initially windy afternoon that gave way to overcast conditions with an hour or so of steady rain.

Looking at the scores, the sloping fairways and the nuances of the pace and breaks on the greens suggest that course was winner for most participants.



Norm Cordina (78) consolidated his position in the SA Order of Merit with a win in the Seniors section. In second place was a welcome visitor in Robert Veit from across the border at Riverside in Mildura (79) and Chris Everett (79) maintaining the Tea Tree Gully representation in the results.

In the Super Seniors, consistent performer John Hill (Mt Osmond) was the winner with 81, from Michael Richards (82), adding his name to the Tea Tree Gully players who take away the spoils and Alan Cooper (Mt Osmond) also 82, having another good result.

Seniors Nett saw Robert Veit (73 off 6) win on a count back from Geoff Beck (Victor Harbor - 73 off 7) followed by the first local in Brian Scarman (75 off 8).

In Super Seniors, Clive Renner (FHGC) and John Hill had 74's and Alan Cooper and Les Seatree (FHGC) 75's.

Nett scores were better than gross but a lot of us would have hoped to do better – next event is at West Lakes in early June.
