PLAYER INFORMATION

Practice rounds

Practice rounds can be booked through the pro shop on (02) 6331 4144.

Format

Play will be from the 1st and 10th. The Women's Championship will be 54-holes over three days. The Men's Championship will be 54-holes over three days, with a seeded draw for the final day of both Championships.

Registration

Please ensure you arrive at least 30 minutes prior to your tee time each day to register. Registration will be in the clubhouse, and must be done each day prior to commencing play. Following this, report to the starter at least 15 minutes prior to your tee time. Your score card, pin positions and local rules will be given to you on the tee.

Score card return and scoring

On completion of your round, please return your scorecard to the registration desk. Live scoring will be displayed in the clubhouse, as well as being available online at www.golfnsw.org.

Rules officials

There will be a roving rules official on course on each day of play. Please utilise them if you need to.

Food & Beverages at Bathurst

There will be no breakfast options provided at Bathurst Golf Club. The club will be open for lunch service for the duration of the event.

Sunday Welcome Dinner

There will be a Welcome Dinner on Sunday evening. This is included in the entry fee for all competitors. **If you are unable to attend, please let Amos know ASAP.** If additional people would like to attend the dinner it will be at a cost of \$40 per person and bookings must be made with Amos Hessel as soon as possible at Amos.Hessel@golfnsw.org

Use of motorized carts

As per the conditions of entry, players may only use a motorized cart if a medical certificate is provided. This must be submitted to the Golf NSW office prior to the tournament. Bookings and payment for carts are the responsibility of the player.

Presentation

Presentation of Men's and Women's prizes will be on completion of play on Tuesday. If you are able to remain for this, please do so.

Withdrawal

If you are unable to participate, please notify us immediately. On presentation of a medical certificate a full refund will be issued, less an administration fee.

Conditions for State Events and Code of Conduct

Player and Caddy Responsibilities

All Players and Caddies must adhere to commonly accepted standards of golfing etiquette and sportsmanship. Care of the course is an important aspect of etiquette and particular attention should be paid to the following:

- Repair divots, carry and use a sand bucket
- Repair pitch marks

A breach may lead to disqualification under Rule 33-7 and/or to disciplinary proceedings under the Golf NSW Code of Conduct. A player is responsible for the actions of their caddy.
