### 2018 COFFS COAST SENIORS CLASSIC CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- 1. Players must be a minimum 50 years of age to compete.
- 2. The Match committee shall have the power to vary these conditions and to decide any dispute or question arising as to the qualifications of any entrant and may in absolute discretion at any time and without assigning reason therefore, refuse any entrant ineligible to compete.
- 3. All play is from the WHITE tees at Coffs Harbour Golf Club and the BLUE tees at Bonville Golf Resort.
- 4. The match committee shall have the power to decide any dispute or question arising as to the qualifications of any entrant and may in absolute discretion at any time without assigning reason therefore, refuse any entrant ineligible to compete.
- 5. Play shall be in accordance with the Rules of Golf and Local Rules of the host club(s)
- 6. Players must use a ball which is named in current R & A Conforming Golf Balls list, a copy of which is available at Golf NSW.
- 7. A player must be a member of a registered Golf Club with a current GA handicap to be eligible for trophies in the event. Members of Social or Online based Golf Clubs will not be eligible to win trophies. All players must have played at least 3 of their last 20 rounds at their home club.
- 8. In the event of a player being suspended by an affiliated club, a club affiliated with the District Golf Association, or a District Golf Association on a golf related matter the player shall not be eligible to enter or play in any Association event during the period of suspension. This by-law shall apply to prevent the player from entering or playing in any such Association event even if he nominates another club as his home club for handicap purposes.

## Protests must be made in writing and submitted to the match committee within fifteen (15) minutes of the conclusion of the day's play.

**9.** A draw for each day's play will be published and players shall start at the time and in the order arranged by the committee. Rule 6-3a provides that "the player shall start at the time laid down by the committee." The penalty for a breach of Rule 6-3a is disqualification. However, it is a condition of the event that, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as proved in Rule 33-7, if the player arrives at his starting point, ready to play, within five minutes after his starting time, the penalty for failing to start on time is loss if the first hole in match play, or two strokes at the first hole in stroke play instead of disqualification.

#### 10. PACE OF PLAY

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group in front. Any group with a clear hole in front of it will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay.

#### 11. BYLAWS, RULES AND DRESS REGULATIONS

The by-law, rules and dress regulations of the host club shall apply. The penalty for non-compliance would be no start or disqualification.

#### **12. MOBILE PHONES**

The use of a mobile phone or portable phone by a competitor or his caddie whilst on the golf course during the event is distracting and inconsiderate. If the competitor or his caddie is in the possession of a mobile or portable phone it should be turned off. If the phone rings this is deemed to be in use and the committee may take disciplinary action against the offending player in accordance with the concluding paragraph of section 1, Etiquette of the Rules of Golf.

#### 13. SUDDEN DEATH

In the event of a tie at the conclusion of play in the 2018 Coffs Coast Seniors Classic for the 36 hole gross prize the winner shall be determined by sudden death playoff.

#### 14. QUALIFYING POSTION FOR NSW SENIOR OPEN CHAMPIONSHIP

The first player (not already qualified for the NSW Men's Senior Open Championship) will gain exemption into the NSW Senior Open Championship. If the Overall Winner of the Coffs Coast Men's Seniors Classic has already qualified for the NSW Men's Senior Open Championship the position will be given to the next best result from the Coffs Coast Men's Seniors Classic with a countback to decide any ties.

#### 15. E-SCORE SCORECARD

A scorecard that is returned without scores written on it and only having the scanning boxes marked will be deemed as disqualified from the event. The score that the player will be attested for will be the score written on the scorecard.

#### 16. ONLY ONE MAJOR PRIZE WILL BE AWARDED TO ANY COMPETITOR.
