CONDITIONS OF ENTRY FOR CARDINIA BEACONHILLS CHALLENGE BOWL

- Aggregate Stableford: Scores of three (3) players added together.
- Entrance fee (which includes GST) must be paid at time of entry.
- All financial members with an official GA handicap are eligible to compete. It is each player's responsibility to ascertain correct handicap.
- The event is open to Amateurs only. The Match Committee of Cardinia Beaconhills Golf Links has the right to refuse entry to any person.
- Competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Club of St Andrew's, Scotland, together with such local rules as are in force on the course on which the competition takes place. If a dispute arises over any rule, it shall be decided by the Match Committee.
- Match Committee will have full power to alter or make any variation to the Conditions should they deem it desirable.
- Match Committee reserves the right to adjust the appointed start time if required.
- Match Committee will endeavour to make players aware of good health practices when playing in adverse weather conditions, when extreme hot weather is forecast, and that the competition be entered at THE PLAYER'S DISCRETION.
- In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided on a count back over the last 9, 6, 3 or 1 holes. Further ties on the first nine holes will be over 6, 3 or 1 holes.
- Any protest must be lodged in writing with the Match Committee on the day of play.
- Golf carts are permissible. A doctor's certificate is not required.
