## MIXED FOURSOMES CHAMPIONSHIP 2018 CONDITIONS OF ENTRY and COMPETITION

1. The GPV Committee in conjunction with Portsea GC (hereinafter referred to as "the Committee") will be responsible for the management of this event.
2. The Rules of Golf will apply, together with the Local Rules of Portsea GC.
3. The event is open to any amateur player holding a Golf Australia handicap at a GPV affiliated club.
4. The entry fee of \$60 per pair must accompany the online entry.
5. If the number of entries exceeds the maximum field capacity (60 players) entrants with the highest GA handicaps will be placed on a wait list. They will be given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals occur. If they do not play their entry fees will be refunded.
6. In adverse weather conditions, or for any other reasons, the Committee may either shorten the event or change to another date and/or venue.
7. Distance Measuring Devices may be used in accordance with Part 5, Appendix IV, on page 181 of the current Rules of Golf.
8. Mobile phones must be turned off and may be used only in an emergency.
9. Players aged 70 years and over may use a motorised golf vehicle.
10. Other competitors who are unable to play except in a motorised golf vehicle must carry a current medical certificate.
11. Players and caddies are required to comply with the dress standards of Portsea GC.
12. The event will be seeded in GA handicap order at the date of entry. The timesheet will be in groups of 6 players.
13. Players are asked to arrive at the course 30 minutes before their tee-time.
14. In the event of a dispute a protest must be made to the Committee within 10 minutes of the conclusion of play. The Committee's decision will be final.
15. Ties - For the scratch Championship there will be a sudden-death playoff over holes to be chosen by the Committee. The handicap winners will be determined by the GA count-back method.
16. Players may win one trophy only. The scratch event takes precedence.
17. GPV vouchers will be awarded to scratch and handicap winners, and golf balls will be given "down the line."
18. Results will be published on the GPV website.
