

Leongatha Golf Club 36 Hole Open Amateur - Sunday 28th October 2018 Men's & Women's 36 Holes Gross & Nett <u>Conditions of Entry</u>

- Entries are to be made no later than October 26th 2018 with the draw to be published on the Leongatha Golf Club website on October 27th 2018. Late entries will be accepted if time sheets are not filled. No entry will be processed without payment. No refunds will be given.
- 2. Entries are restricted to amateurs who are members of clubs of Golf Victoria or of golf clubs registered with state or overseas associations as are affiliated with or recognised by the Association, or of clubs affiliated with the VGL, and the Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- 3. Competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews Scotland, together with such local rules as are in force on the links over which the competition takes place. If a dispute arises on any point it shall be decided by the committee in charge of the competition, whose decision shall be final. If in doubt the Tournament Committee shall have the right to refer such dispute to Golf Victoria.
- 4. Any protest must be lodged in writing at the Clubhouse no later than 30 minutes after conclusion of the day's play.
- 5. All competitors will be made Honorary Members of the Leongatha Golf Club Inc. for the duration of the tournament.
- 6. Ties in 36-hole scratch singles events shall be decided by sudden death playoff or as otherwise decided by the Tournament Committee. Ties in all other events shall be decided by countback as laid down by Golf Australia.
- 7. The Tournament Committee (comprising members appointed by the LGC) or such persons as they may authorise shall have the following powers:
 - a) To vary handicap limits and allocation of divisions in events played in two or more grades.
 - b) To permit any competitor who is not ready to start at his appointed time to start at a later time.
 - c) In every event to draw competitors against each other for the day, in such a manner as they may arrange.
 - d) To shorten any contest.
 - e) To alter or vary the conditions should they deem it advisable (except 2 and 3).
 - f) To limit the number of entries in any event and to alter the time of starting of any event.
- 8. Handicaps: Competitors must have a current Golf Australia handicap and be able to produce their Golf Link card if requested. Men's maximum handicap, 36.4. Ladies maximum handicap, 45.4.
- 9. No competitors shall be entitled to more than one trophy on any one day. NTPs not included in this condition.
