

**MURRAY BRIDGE JUNIOR OPEN**  
**CONDITIONS OF PLAY**  
**(Includes Murraylands Boys 'Closed' Junior Championship event)**

1. Field open to Boys & Girls under age of 18years on the day of event.
2. Boys & Girls (separate) Events - Played over 18 holes. (Stroke/Nett)
3. Max handicaps Boys 36 – Girls 45.
4. Ties for Gross Winner of both Boys & Girls Championship to be decided by a sudden death play-off. (using holes 1 & 18) All other positions to be decided by a count back. In the event of insufficient time the Match Committee may opt to revert to a countback system in all instances.
5. No player shall be entitled to receive more than one major trophy – (Exception Murraylands Closed event)
6. **Caddies – Parents/carers are NOT entitled to caddie their own child.**
7. Players may only use ride-on motorised vehicles if they present a Dr's Certificate. **Caddies NOT permitted to use ride-on motorised carts.**
8. Murraylands "CLOSED" Boys Championship (27 holes) Boys must be a member of a M/Lands Club to qualify.
9. Entries close Friday 5<sup>th</sup> Oct. (Late entries only accepted at discretion of Match Committee)
10. The Match Committee shall have the power to decide any other condition which arises, that is not mentioned or covered above.

**NOTES:**

- Unfortunately there is no separate practice fairway at Murray Bridge.  
In view of the early starting time for this event, the use of the designated 10<sup>th</sup> practice area is not permitted at any stage after 7:45am and **all** practice balls **must** be collected prior to 8am.
- Use of Nets and practice putting area available at any time.
- NO chipping allowed onto 18<sup>th</sup> or 10<sup>th</sup> Greens prior to hit off.
- There is a short distance chipping flag area located between the 8<sup>th</sup> Green and the boundary line fence which can be used anytime.
