

Dress Code - On Course

Men On Course – Acceptable



- ✓ Accredited golf style shoes without metal spikes
- ✓ Sports shoes may be permitted under special circumstances
- ✓ Trousers and shorts must be tailored and worn with a belt
- ✓ Shirts must have collars or PGA approved crew neck style high collars and must be tucked in at all times
- ✓ White socks or sockettes

Women On Course – Acceptable



- ✓ Accredited golf style shoes without metal spikes
- ✓ Sports shoes may be permitted under special circumstances
- ✓ Slacks, skirts, skorts or shorts provided they are not abbreviated, tight fitting or in the nature of leggings
- ✓ Collared shirts with or without sleeves and may be worn out if designed to do so
- ✓ White socks or sockettes

Not Acceptable On Course

- ✗ Clothing that displays excessive logos or advertising
- ✗ Black socks
- ✗ Denim clothing, cargos or tracksuits
- ✗ T-shirts, singlet tops and hooded tops

Dress Code - Clubhouse

Clubhouse – Acceptable

- ✓ Clothing and footwear must be neat, tidy and in good repair
- ✓ Golf attire worn to the acceptable course standard is permitted
- ✓ Men's shirts must be tucked in at all times
- ✓ Females may wear shirts untucked if designed to do so
- ✓ Non-metal spiked golf shoes
- ✓ Socks are optional with boat shoes and moccasins
- ✓ Dress sandals (women)

Clubhouse – Not Acceptable

- ✗ Denim clothing, cargos or tracksuits are NOT permitted
- ✗ T-shirts, singlet tops and hooded tops are NOT permitted
- ✗ Bare feet or thongs are NOT permitted
- ✗ Sporting hats and caps are NOT permitted
- ✗ Torn, faded or untidy clothing is NOT permitted

Use of Mobile Phones

- ✓ Mobile phones must be switched off or set to silent but may be used for emails or internet
- ✗ Phone calls must NOT be conducted on the course or in the dining and bar areas unless in an emergency situation
