CONDITIONS OF PLAY

DATES

Saturday 6th October and Sunday 7th October 2018.

COMPETITION:-

The City of Ipswich Open is a 36 Hole Stroke Play event, played over consecutive days. It is open to all male amateur golfers with a Golf Australia Handicap who are members of a Golf Club affiliated through their District Golf Association with Golf Queensland or from other State/National or similar Over Seas Golf Associations. The winner will be the player with the lowest 36 Hole Aggregate Gross Score.

No Practice is permitted on the Course between Rounds.

For Day 2, the top 8 players will be seeded. Seeded players must play at the allotted Tee times to be eligible for the Major Trophy (The City of Ipswich Open Cup).

In the event of a tie for the 36 Hole Gross Trophy (Event 1), a sudden death play-off will be held on Holes 18 &, 9, or as decided by the Match Committee. Ties in all other events will be decided by the prescribed count back procedure.

The Tournament Committee reserves the right to alter the Conditions of Entry and to grant special exemption to any person it deems appropriate.

HANDICAPS:-

Reductions will be made to Handicaps prior to the 2nd Round, and these lower handicaps will apply to the Sunday 18 Hole Nett events only.

TROPHIES:- 36 Hole Gross and Nett Winners and Runners Up in A, B & C grades.

18 Hole Gross and Nett Winners in A, B & C grades.

36 Hole Gross Senior and Junior championship

(Trophies subject to sufficient numbers of players entering for the Event. The Golf Club reserves the right to add or delete events).

Players are eligible to win one (1) Major Trophy only.

NTP'S and Ball Rundowns are not considered Major Trophies.

PRESENTATIONS:-

All Trophies will be presented after the completion of the last Round.

BUGGIES:-

Motorised Buggies are permitted for all Events except the Open 36 hole Gross Events.

DRESS CODE:-

Players are expected to maintain a dress standards as per the dress requirements of the Ipswich Golf Club and Ipswich Sports Club

The Match Committee reserves the right to declare a Winner in respect of any of the Events over a reduced number of Holes (i.e. Less than 36) should conditions deem it necessary/appropriate. Its decisions are final and no discussion will be entered into. Queries or complaints shall be put in writing to the Match Committee within 15 minutes of the completion of the player's Round.
