Conditions of Play

- 1. 36 hole event of individual stroke play, played over 2 consecutive days (18 holes per day)
- 2. Entrants are required to hold a current GA handicap, be a male member of a golf club affiliated through their District Golf Association with Golf Queensland, or other State/National Golf Associations—Playing Grades: "A" Grade up to 12, "B" Grade 13-19, "C" Grade 20-36
- 3. Grades will be determined by handicaps on Saturday 20th October.

 Players handicaps will be recalculated for 21st October.

 Players will remain in the same grade but will play off their daily handicap.
- 4. All players are required to report to officials at least 10 minutes prior to starting.
- 5. The Rules of Golf shall apply together with the Local Rules. The decision of the Match Committee shall be final in all matters relating to the tournament. Any dispute or protest must be lodged in writing at the clubhouse within 15 minutes of the completion of the round on the day on which the dispute has arisen.
- **6.** In the event of a tie for either the open Gross or open Junior winner, the event will be decided by a "sudden death "play off on the 1st, 8th & 9th. If more than two players are tied, the Runner-Up will be decided by a countback on the last 18 holes. All other ties will be resolved by countback.
- 7. Should either round be cancelled then the Championship will be decided on the round played. Trophies will be adjusted accordingly.
- 8. Prior to round 1 the Match Committee will release a list of players (approx. 20) who will be considered Marquee players. These players names will not appear on the draw for Sunday. On Sunday a draw for the leading gross scores (approx. 20) will be conducted. While every effort will be made to contact players, it remains the player's responsibility to confirm their tee time. Marquee players not making the leading players draw will be allocated a tee time at the discretion of the Match Committee. Should a eligible player fail to play within the Leading Players Draw he will be excluded from Event No 1.
- **9.** Players may win only one of the listed trophies. All players are eligible for relevant *nearest the pin* shots and *long drives*. Winners of 36 hole events are not eligible for ball run downs.
- 10. Practice on the course between rounds is **not** permitted. (Rule 7-1b) Penalty Disqualification.
- 11. All advertising signage to be treated as Immovable Obstructions relief as per Rule 24 -2.
- **12.** Motorised buggies may be used by all competitors in all events.
