## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

- 1. The Tournament Committee shall consist of selected members of The Rosanna Golf Club Committee and shall have the entire management of the Event and full power to alter or vary conditions of the Tournament, shall be able to fix and make alterations to any handicap before the event. All ties will be decided by the current A.G.U. countback method.
- 2. Entries are restricted to Amateurs who are members of the Clubs of the Golf Victoria, or of Golf Clubs registered with such State or Overseas Associations as are affiliated with or recognised by GV or the Clubs affiliated with the Victorian Golf League.
- 3. Competitions shall be played in accordance with the rules of golf as adopted by The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, Scotland, together with such local rules as are in force at the course over which the competition takes place. If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Tournament Committee, whose decision shall be final. In the absence of the full Tournament Committee such number thereof as may be present at any time may give a decision and any decision so given shall be deemed to be the decision of the full Tournament Committee.
- 4. The entrance fee must be paid at the time of entry, and entries shall only be made on the form issued by The Rosanna Golf Club and lodged with the Tournament Secretary on or before Thursday 19th October 2017.
- 5. If entries are excessive the Tournament Committee will establish an emergency list.
- 6. Handicap Limit: Players of all handicaps may participate but on the day no lady will play off a handicap greater than 36 and no man will play off a handicap greater than 27. An entrant must notify the Tournament Secretary at Player registration of any alteration in handicap subsequent to the closing date of entries.
- 7. On the day of the Tournament all players must report to the Registration Desk by 12.30pm. Rule 6-3A provides "that the player shall start at the time laid down by the Committee". The penalty for breach of Rule 6-3A is disqualification. However, it is a condition of the competition, that in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, if the player arrives at his/her starting point, ready to play, within 5 minutes of his/her starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two (2) strokes at the first hole instead of disqualification.
- 8. It will be obligatory for all competitors in all events to play with any ball which is named in the current R & A and/or U.S.G.A. list.
- 9. Protests must be made to the Tournament Committee not later than 15 minutes after the completion of the day's play.
- 10. Competitors will be made honorary members for the day.
- 11. Undue Delay Rules of golf 6-7 applies. Pace of play will be monitored and be in accordance with GV guidelines.
- 12. Practice Rules of golf 7-1B applies.
- 13. Dress All Players are expected to dress in a clean and tidy manner and must observe the following dress standards.
  - Men Tailored long trousers or tailored belted shorts (no draw string or jean style) with long socks or <u>plain</u> <u>white</u> sports socks are permitted. No cargo style pants with external or zippered pockets. Collared shirts or specific golf shirts to be worn.
  - Ladies A skirt, tailored pants or tailored shorts are permitted. Tank tops, singlet tops, halter necks, bare midriffs, track/leisure suits are not permitted.
  - Golf shoes with spikes (soft or metal) or dimple soles must be worn.
  - Denim jeans or jackets, boxer, board, football, running or surf type shorts are not permitted.
- 14. The winner of each event will receive a trophy except that a competitor will be permitted to win one (1) trophy only. Presentation of trophies will be held during the presentation dinner.
- 15. Open to all playing categories of membership.
