

ROOKIE SERIES PITCH N PUTT – TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

(To be read in conjunction with the Golf Australia's Standard Event Conditions as published on the GA Website at www.golf.org.au)

1. COMPETITION PROCEDURES

- 1.1 The event is scheduled to be played over 18 holes stroke play.
- 1.2 The field for the event will be limited to 72 players.
- 1.3 Entries will be accepted on an as received basis until the field capacity is reached.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 Eligible players are male & female amateurs who are aged under 16 as at the first day of the competition.

3. ENTRIES

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$20 (inc. GST). Entry fee must be paid at the time of entry.
- 3.2 The Tournament Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- 3.3 Entries shall only be made online at www.golfvic.org.au.
- 3.4 The draw for the competition will be sent to players and available at www.golfvic.org.au approximately five days before the event.
- 3.5 Entry will close one week prior to the event.

4. TROPHIES

- 4.1 The male and female player with the lowest stroke score shall be the respective Pitch n Putt Champions for that term.
- 4.3 In addition, the gross and nett winner for each age division will receive a trophy.
- 4.4 Nett trophies will be decided by the Australian Pitch'n'Putt (par 3) Callaway Handicapping System. In case of a tie the Pitch'n'Putt count back method will be used to separate all trophies.
- 4.5 No player may win more than one trophy in their age group.
- 4.6 A minimum of 4 entries is required to constitute an age division. If insufficient entries are received players will move up to and compete in the next age division and/or for overall prizes.

5. CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE

The Championship Committee shall consist of representatives of host clubs and Golf Australia. In the absence of the full Championship Committee, present members of the committee at any time may give a decision and any decision shall be deemed the decision of the full Championship Committee. The Championship Committee reserves the right to vary any condition of this event. In the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, the Championship Committee may shorten the competition, appoint another day or days for completion of, or may transfer play to another course. The decision of the Championship Committee will be final in all matters relating to the Tournament.

6. OTHER

- 6.1 Each group must be accompanied by an adult during the event whose responsibilities include safety and scoring where necessary.
- 6.2 Once a player has eight strokes on any hole, the ball must be lifted with 8 placed against the relevant hole on the scorecard. No further strokes are permitted on the hole.

7. DATABASE OF COMPETITOR'S DETAILS

The personal data contained in this entry is permanently retained by Golf Australia. This data may be utilised by Golf Australia or its sponsors for the distribution of correspondence, in both electronic and hard copy means. From time to time players may be sent entry forms, event literature, the Golf Australia e-newsletter, or marketing material by the sponsor(s) of Golf Australia events, or information about events conducted by Golf Australia approved bodies. Upon receipt by Golf Australia of a written request, a player may either have access to their details, or have their details deleted from the database.
