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CONDITIONS OF PLAY

- 1. Entrance Fees must be paid at the time of entry and will not be refunded after the event closing date.
- 2. The event is open to Amateurs only who are members of a GA affiliated Golf Club. The Lady Members Committee of the Berwick Montuna Golf Club have the right to refuse entry to any person without being requested to provide any reason for such refusal. Open Day major trophies cannot be won by a Member / Member pair from Berwick Montuna Golf Club.
- 3. The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal & Ancient Club of St Andrew's Scotland, together with such local rules as are in force on the course on which the competition takes place. If a dispute arises over any rule, it shall be decided by the Ladies Match Committee.
- 4. The Committee will make arrangements, and will have full power to alter or make any variations to the Conditions should they deem fit.
- 5. The Committee may in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, either shorten the contest or select another day.
- 6. In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided on a countback over the last 9, 6 or 3 holes, per the GA Yearbook.
- 7. Any protest must be lodged in writing with the Lady Captain before trophies are presented on the day on which the disputed matter has arisen.
- 8. The Committee reserves the right to adjust the appointed start time if required.
- 9. GA Handicap Certificates or Golf link cards may be requested as evidence of correct handicap.
