# **Cromer Senior Open Conditions of Competition**

#### THE COMMITTEE

- The Committee in charge of all competitions is the Cromer Match Committee
- In the absence of the full Committee, such members as may be present at the time may give a decision and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Committee.
- The Committee will have the sole management and control of the Competition with full power at any time to alter or vary any conditions (including but not limited to scheduling, qualifying round conditions and duration of competition due to climatic or course conditions).
- The Committee's decision on matters affecting the Competition will be final.

#### **ELIGIBILTY**

- Competition is open to all male members of affiliated Clubs who are over the age of 55 years.
- Player must hold a current Golf Australia handicap.

#### **RULES**

- The Rules of Golf, Local Rules printed on the back of the scorecard plus any temporary Local Rules displayed on the Pro Shop pillar will apply to the competition.
- The event is also played under the conditions of Golf NSW SOOM events.

#### **FORMAT**

- Competition of the day is a Stroke play (scratch) event. Players will be required to complete each hole and record the numbers of strokes taken on their scorecard.
- Nett prizes will also be awarded based on player entries.

#### **GROUPS AND STARTING**

- On the day of the competition the names and times on the starting sheet become the time and order of starting by the Committee. Players wishing to cancel must do so prior to the draw being published to be eligible for a refund of fees.
- All competitors must be present and ready to play at the time established by the Committee (refer Rule 6-3a).

### SUSPENSION OF PLAY

- In the event of lightning in the proximity of the course or the course becoming unplayable, a siren will be sounded. These signals apply:
  - o **Discontinue play immediately:** one prolonged siren (dangerous situation)
  - o **Discontinue play:** three consecutive notes of the siren, repeated (course unplayable)
  - o **Resume play:** Two short notes of siren, repeated
- See Rule 6-8 for the procedure in discontinuing and resuming play.

#### **TIES**

• Will be decided by count back as per the Golf Australia guidelines.

#### **PROTESTS**

• Protests regarding play in the competition must be made to the Captain, Committee (or representative thereof) or General Manager immediately after the cessation of play.
