Conditions

1. Format

- 1.1 Played over 36 holes, 18 holes each day
- 1.2 Boys & Girls gross event for players with a GA handicap of 17.9 or less as of first day of play. Boys & Girls stableford event for players with a GA handicap of 18.0 and above as of first day of play. Handicap ranges are subject to change without notice based on entry numbers.
- 1.3 In the event of a tie for first place in the gross event, unless the Match Committee determines otherwise, players in such a tie will continue play over such holes as the Match Committee will decide, in a sudden-death, hole-by-hole playoff until the winner is determined. Ties for other place-getters will be decided by countback.

2. Handicaps

- 2.1 Players to use their first day handicap for the 36 holes.

3. Match Committee

- 3.1 The Match Committee will comprise the SA Match Committee.
- 3.2 In the absence of the full Match Committee, such members as may be present at the time, may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Match Committee.
- 3.3 The Match Committee will have the sole management and control of the event, with full power at any time to alter or vary any one of the Conditions.
- 3.4 The Match Committee's decision on matters affecting the event will be final.
- 3.5 Any dispute or protest must be made to the Match Committee not more than 15 minutes after the conclusion of play on the day on which the disputed matter has arisen.

4. Rules of Play

- 4.1 The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R & A Rules Limited, will apply together with Local Rules of the venue Club.

5. Entries

- 5.1 Eligible players for the event are junior boy and girl Amateur Golfers who are members of Golf Clubs affiliated with Golf Australia or overseas associations as are affiliated with or recognised by this Association and who satisfy the necessary handicap and age qualifications.
- 5.2 The Entrance Fee for the event is \$25.00 (including GST), and must be paid at the time of entry.
- 5.3 Entries must be made via the online registration system. Entries by any other method will not be accepted.
- 5.4 The decision of the Match Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.
- 5.5 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Match Committee.
- 5.6 Players must register by 5:00pm on Monday 14th January 2019. **IT IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT THEMSELVES TO ENSURE THAT THEY HAVE REGISTERED CORRECTLY.** A player has not officially registered until their name is listed in the **registered Participants** section of the event registration page.
- 5.7 Entrance fees will only be refunded in the case of a withdrawal being advised before the closing date for registrations.

6. Caddies

- 6.1 Caddies are permitted for players aged **13 years of age and under** as at the first day of competition. Caddies are not permitted for players aged **14 years and above** as of the first day of competition.

7. Conforming Golf Balls and Conforming Driver Heads

- 7.1 The specimen conditions in the Rules of Golf are in effect as regards Conforming Golf Balls and Conforming Driver Heads.

8. Drug Testing

- 8.1 All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Agency for banned substances as laid down in Golf Australia's Anti-Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy, or refusing to take a test, will be disqualified and subject to any sanction(s) brought down by ASADA.

9. Smoking

- 9.1 Players and caddies are prohibited from smoking cigarettes, cigars or the like during a stipulated round. See Golf Australia's Code of Conduct.

10. Mobile Phones

- 10.1 Except in case of emergency, mobile phones must not be used to make or receive calls or messages when on the golf course.

11. Unreasonable Delay; Prompt Pace of Play

- 11.1 Rule 5.6 will be strictly enforced. A player must not unreasonably delay play either when playing a hole, or between two holes.

12. Motorised Transport

- 12.1 Ride-on buggies will be permitted only on medical evidence from the player and by permission of the venue Club. Applications and approvals to be forwarded to Golf Australia at time of registration. Caddies are not permitted to use ride-on buggies.

13. Code of Conduct

- 13.1 All entrants assent to be bound by Golf Australia's Code of Conduct. A copy of the Code is available at www.golf.org.au/golfsa

14. Measuring Devices

- 14.1 A player may obtain distance only information by use of a distance-measuring device.

15. Draws

- 15.1 Tee times will be available on www.golf.org.au/golfsa from Wednesday 16th January 2019.

16. Photography

- 16.1 By entering the event, you agree to having your photo taken of which may be published on social media for promotional purposes.
