CONDITIONS

1. Format

- 1.1 The Boy's & Girl's Championship will be played over 54 holes 36 holes stroke play Monday and 18 holes stroke play Tuesday.
- 1.2 In the event of a tie for first place, unless the Match Committee determines otherwise, players in such a tie will continue play over such holes as the Match Committee will decide, in a sudden-death, hole-by-hole playoff until the winner is determined. Ties for other place-getters will be decided by countback.

2. Match Committee

- 2.1 The Match Committee will comprise the SA Match Committee.
- 2.2 In the absence of the full Match Committee, such members as may be present at the time, may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Match Committee.
- 2.3 The Match Committee will have the sole management and control of the Championship, with full power at any time to alter or vary any one of the Conditions.
- 2.4 The Match Committee's decision on matters affecting the Championship will be final.
- 2.5 Any dispute or protest must be made to the Match Committee not more than 15 minutes after the conclusion of play on the day on which the disputed matter has arisen.

3. Rules of Play

3.1 The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R & A Rules Limited, will apply together with Local Rules of the venue Club.

4. Entries

- 4.1 Eligible players for the Championship are junior boy and girl Amateur Golfers who are members of Golf Clubs affiliated with Golf Australia or overseas associations as are affiliated with or recognised by this Association and who satisfy the necessary handicap and age qualifications.
- 4.2 The Entrance Fee for the Championship is \$60.00 (including GST), and must be paid at the time of entry.
- 4.3 Entries must be made via the SA online registration system. Entries by any other method will not be accepted.
- 4.4 The decision of the Match Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.
- 4.5 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Match Committee.
- 4.6 Players must register by 5:00pm on Thursday 27th December 2018. IT IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT THEMSELVES TO ENSURE THAT THEY HAVE REGISTERED CORRECTLY. A player has not officially registered until their name is listed in the registered Participants section of the event registration page.
- 4.7 The Match Committee reserves the right to determine the size of the field with a maximum combined field side being 90 players. The field must comprise a minimum number of 36 boys and 36 girls (registrations permitting). If a ballot is required, the higher handicap competitors as at the closing date of registrations will be eliminated first. Unsuccessful entrants will be informed without delay. Entrance fees will be refunded to competitors balloted out.

- 4.8 Subject to the general age and eligibility requirements, the following players shall be exempt from any ballot;
 - a. 2018 SA Junior Boys and Girls State Team members
 - **b**. Any special exemptions at discretion of the Golf Australia (SA division) Match Committee
- 4.9 Entrance fees will only be refunded in the case of a withdrawal being advised before the closing date for registrations, except for those entrants who fail to secure a place.

5. Caddies

5.1 Caddies are <u>permitted</u> for players aged 13 years of age and under as at the first day of competition. Caddies are <u>not permitted</u> for players aged 14 years and above as of the first day of competition.

6. Conforming Golf Balls and Conforming Driver Heads

6.1 The specimen conditions in the Rules of Golf are in effect in regard to Conforming Golf Balls and Conforming Driver Heads.

7. Drug Testing

7.1 All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Agency for banned substances as laid down in Golf Australia's Anti-Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy, or refusing to take a test, will be disqualified and subject to any sanction(s) brought down by ASADA.

8. Smoking

8.1 Players and caddies are prohibited from smoking cigarettes, cigars or the like during a stipulated round. See Golf Australia's Code of Conduct.

9. Mobile Phones

9.1 Except in case of emergency, mobile phones must not be used to make or receive calls or messages when on the golf course.

10. Unreasonable Delay; Prompt Pace of Play

10.1 Rule 5.6 will be strictly enforced. A player must not unreasonably delay play, either when playing a hole or between two holes.

11. Motorised Transport

11.1 Ride-on buggies will be permitted only on medical evidence and by permission of the venue Club. Applications and approvals to be forwarded to Golf Australia - SA at time of registration. Caddies are not permitted to use ride-on buggies.

12. Code of Conduct

12.1 All entrants assent to be bound by Golf Australia's Code of Conduct. A copy of the Code is available at www.golf.org.au/golfsa

13. Measuring Devices

13.1 A player may obtain distance only information by use of a distance-measuring device.

14. Draws

14.1 Tee times will be available on www.golf.org.au/golfsa from Thursday 3rd January 2019.

15. Photography
