Format: 72-holes, Stroke-Play. In the event of a tie, a sudden-death playoff will take

place. The leading 70 players and ties after 36 holes will qualify for the 3rd

and 4th rounds.

- 2. 23 places as agreed between ALPG and GA, not including those who qualify in 1 above.
- 3. Five (5) ISPS Exemptions
- 4. Four (5) Swinging Skirt Exemptions
- 5. One (1) JTBC Exemption
- 6. Five (4) Golf Australia Invitations
- 7. Three (3) Golf Australia Amateur Exemptions as follows:
 - i. 2019 Australian Amateur Champion
 - ii. 2018 Australian Girls' Amateur Champion
 - iii. 2018 Aaron Baddeley World Junior Champion
- 8. Three (3) players from qualifying

CADDIES

Players are not permitted to use a pull buggy/trolley and must have a caddie.

The fee for a local caddie is AUD \$100.00 daily, not including gratuity.

Caddies will not be provided for those players who do not advise at the time of entry or contact Golf Australia. A professional caddie may assist with yardages, etc. a Bag Carrier will only carry the bag.

<u>Caddie requests MUST be received by Golf Australia prior to 5:00 pm on Friday 8 February 2019.</u> The tournament organisers will make every effort to cater for the type of caddie a player requests but cannot guarantee that the specific caddie will be available.

GROOVE AND PUNCH MARK SPECIFICATIONS

The following regulation applies to the Championship Proper only:

"In making a stroke, the player must use clubs that conform to the groove and punch mark specifications in the Equipment Rules that took effect on 1 January 2010. An Equipment Database of fairway woods, hybrids, irons and wedges which have been tested for conformance to the current Equipment Rules is found at RandA.org.

Penalty For Making a Stroke with Club in Breach of this Local Rule: Disqualification. (There is no penalty under this Local Rule for carrying but not making a stroke with a club which does not conform to these groove and punch mark specifications.)
