

PLAY 9 AT THE AUSTRALIAN OPEN

In NSW and the ACT, 155 Clubs participated in the national Play 9 Initiative, for the chance to win:

- A spot in the National Final of the Play 9 Tournament at the end of play on Day 3 of the 2018 Australian Open Championship at The Lakes Golf Club
- Travel to and Accommodation for the event
- An invitation to the Champion's Cocktail Function

Of the 155 participating Clubs:

- 45 were from the Metropolitan area of NSW
- 110 were from regional NSW and the ACT
- 8,229 individual golfers played 9-hole rounds during the qualifying period
- A total of 39,608 9-hole rounds were played!
