#### **AGE ELIGIBILITY**

All competitors are to be under the age of 18 years as at 8 January 2019

#### **HANDICAP LIMITS**

Boys: Maximum GA Handicap – 25.8

Girls: Maximum GA Handicap – 36.3

Grade divisions for boys will be determined based upon entry numbers.

#### **DRESS REQUIREMENTS**

Dress standards will apply to all players, caddies and spectators whilst on the course and in the clubhouse. Note: jeans or runners are not permitted.

## **TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS:**

The Kingston Heath Golf Club Junior Open Amateur ~ Tuesday 8 January 2019

- 1. Entries:** All entries must be made via Golf Victoria Online Registration Portal. Entry fees must be paid at the time of entry, otherwise entries will be rejected. Refunds will not be made for cancellation after the closing date. Entries are restricted to amateurs who are current members of other clubs affiliated with Golf Victoria, or of golf clubs registered with such state or overseas associations which are recognised by these bodies, or of golf clubs affiliated with the VGL. The Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- 2. Tournament Committee:** The Kingston Heath Golf Club Junior Committee shall have the entire management responsibility for the tournament, including the authority to make variations in the conditions should they deem it desirable or necessary.
- 3. Number of Entries:** The Committee shall have the authority to limit the number of entries accepted. A maximum field of 108 players is allowed.
- 4. Players must be prepared to play at the scheduled time of 7.30am, and must report to the golf shop at least 30 minutes prior to the scheduled starting time.**
- 5. Rules:** The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews, together with such local rules that are in force at the time of the competition. All disputes shall be decided by the Committee, whose decision shall be final. Provided, however, that the Committee if in doubt shall have the right to refer any such dispute to Golf Victoria, whose decision shall be final. Any such dispute must be made in writing to the Committee not later than fifteen (15) minutes after completion of the day's play.
- 6. Ties:** In the event of a tie, the winner shall be determined on count-back under the system recommended by Golf Australia.
- 7. Weather Provision:** The Committee may, in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, either cancel, shorten the competition, or postpone it to another day.
- 8. Dress Code:** All competitors will be made Honorary Members of the Club for the duration of the tournament. Dress standards will apply to all players, caddies and spectators whilst on the course and in the clubhouse. Note: jeans or runners are not permitted.
- 9. Golf Shoes:** Soft spike golf shoes are compulsory.
- 10. Age Eligibility:** All players must be under eighteen (18) years of age as at 8 January 2019.
- 11. Handicap Eligibility:** The tournament is open to all amateur junior players within the following handicap limits:  
Girls – 36.3 and under; Boys – 25.8 and under.
- 12. Draw:** The draw will be distributed to all players via email.
- 13. Disclaimer/Waiver:** Competitors, caddies and spectators understand and acknowledge that entry is done so waiving the Kingston Heath Golf club of liability for personal injury, property damage or loss, that may be sustained to/by any competitor, caddie or spectators as a result of anticipation in the tournament unless caused by the proven negligence of the host club. Competitors authorise the host club, the tournament committee or its representatives to seek medical assistance as they see fit and agree to meet all expenses as incurred. By entering the tournament competitors fully understand and consent to the activities to be undertaken and to the location of the activities. By signing the tournament entry form, competitors acknowledge they understand and agree to all tournament conditions.
- 14. Marketing /Promotion:** All competitors by way of entry give Kingston Heath Golf Club full permission to use photography and images taken during the course of conducting this tournament for publicity and marketing purposes.
