

2019 Boroondara Cup & Boroondara Classic

Event Conditions

1. The Tournament Committee shall consist of selected members of Green Acres Golf Club, The Kew Golf Club and members of the Match Committee of the Club on whose course the rounds are being played and shall have the entire management of the Event and full power to alter or vary conditions (excepting Clauses 2 and 3) of the programme, shall be able to fix and make alterations to any handicap before the event and shall determine the manner in which ties will be decided. In the case of the Boroondara Cup and Boroondara Classic, ties will be played off over such holes as the Tournament Committee may direct. Other ties will be decided by the current Golf Australia countback method.
2. Entries are restricted to amateurs who are members of the Clubs of Golf Victoria, or of Golf Clubs registered with such State or Overseas Associations as are affiliated with or recognised by Golf Victoria or the Clubs affiliated with the Victorian Golf League. The Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
3. Competitions shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by The Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, Scotland, together with such local rules as are in force at the courses over which the competition takes place. If a dispute arises on any point, it shall be decided by the Tournament Committee, whose decision shall be final. In the absence of a full Tournament Committee such number thereof as may be present at the time may give a decision and any decision so given shall be deemed to be the decision of the full Tournament Committee.
4. The entrance fee of \$80 inc. G.S.T must be paid at the time of entry by the advertised date. Entries will be accepted via the Golf Australia online entry system only. Manual entries may be accepted at the discretion of the host club. Payment will be made online using the Paypal gateway using credit card or Paypal account.
5. If entries are excessive the Tournament Committee reserves the right to ballot out entrants according to handicaps.
6. Exempt players include last year's winners and the Club Champions of both Green Acres Golf Club and The Kew Golf Club, both male and female.
7. Starting Times: Players must report to the Registration Desk at least 15 minutes before their starting time. Rule 5.3a (When to Start Round) governs the conditions upon which all start times for competitors will be treated.
8. The Golf Australia Code of Conduct will be enforced.
9. Golf Balls: It will be obligatory for all competitors in all events to play with any ball which is named in the current R&A and/or U.S.G.A. list.
10. Protests must be made to the Tournament Committee not later than 15 minutes after the completion of the day's play.
11. Competitors will be made Honorary Members for the day.

Undue Delay Pace of play will be monitored and be in accordance with Rule 5.6b.

Practice Practice on the course prior or between rounds is prohibited. Rule 5.2b applies.
