1. ELIGIBILITY.

Eligible players are male amateurs who have reached their 55th birthday on or before February 6th 2019 and whose Australian Handicap does not exceed 27 at the time of entry.

2. CHAMPIONSHIP PROCEDURES.

2.1 The Championship shall be played over 54 holes of stroke-play. 18 holes on Wed 6th, Thurs 7th & Friday 8th February 2019

2.2 Two Divisions

Division 1- Handicaps of Scratch – 13 | Division 2- Handicaps of 14 – 27

2.3 Championship Trophies

18 Hole Gross & Nett prizes in each Division each day. (Please note participants are eligible to win ONE(1) 54 Hole Trophy, one(1) Trophies presented daily. 18 Hole Trophy and one(1) age group Trophy)

3. CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE.

3.1 The Championship Committee shall comprise of members of the Host Club and one Member of Golf Tasmania.

3.2 In the absence of the full Championship Committee, such members thereof as may be present at any time may give a decision and any such decision shall be deemed the decision of the full Championship Committee.

3.3 The Championship Committee decisions matters affecting the Championship shall be final. Protests must be in writing and submitted to the Championship Committee within fifteen(15) minutes of the conclusion of the day's play except on the final day when they must be made within five(5) minutes of the conclusion of play.

3.4 The decision of the Championship Committee as to the acceptance or refusal of any entries shall be final.

4. RULES OF PLAY.

The Rules of Golf as adopted by the R&A Rules Limited will apply together with such Local Rules as are approved by the Championship Committee.

5. ENTRIES.

5.1 Entries shall only be made on the official Entry Form or photocopy thereof or online at

5.2 Entrants must conform in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status, as adopted by the R&A Rules Limited, and shall sign a declaration, contained in the entry form, to that effect.

5.3 Fully completed entry forms together with entrance fee or online registration must be received by the Executive Officer, Mowbray Golf Club Inc., no later than 5pm Friday January 25th 2019

6. DRAW AND STARTING TIMES.

6.1 A draw for each day's play shall be published. Players shall start at the time and in the order arranged by the Championship Committee as provided in Rule 6-3a

6.2 The draw for the first day's play will be emailed and will also be available at www.mowbraygolfclub.com.au.

6.3 The Championship Committee reserves the right to fix and/or alter starting times.

7. THE BALL.

7.1 It is obligatory for all competitors in the Championship to play with a golf ball which is named in the current Royal and Ancient and/or USGA Conforming Balls List.

7.2 Throughout a stipulated round the player is limited to use golf balls with identical markings, except that the identification no. may differ by number only, not by colour. Penalty: 2 strokes for each hole at which any breach occurred, maximum penalty per round is four strokes.

8. PRACTICE.

After 1pm on Monday 4th and Tuesday 5th February 2019 by liaison with Club Professional – 6326 3832

9. USE OF MOTORISED VEHICLES.

During play, it is prohibited for a player to ride in or on a motorised vehicle unless specific written permission has been granted by the Championship Committee. (NB subject to host club permission, a caddie may use motorised transport at any time) Penalty: two(2) strokes for each hole at which a breach occurred: maximum penalty per round- four(4) strokes (unless permitted to ride by a member of the Championship Rules Committee). Procedure when breach discovered: Use of any unauthorised form of transport must be discontinued immediately upon discovery that a breach has occurred.

Note i: Permission will only be granted to entrants who can provide a Medical Certificate.

Note ii: Golf Tasmania takes no responsibility for the availability of golf carts.

Note iii: Permission will be granted on the basis that the following requirements are adhered to. Players failing to adhere to these requirements are liable to have such permission revoked: Players who drive at a pace which is clearly quicker than walking pace; and/or drive to a point past their ball which is clearly unreasonable for a player who is not using motorised transport to reach, are in breach of these requirements. Stroke- In the event of a breach between the play of two holes, the penalty applies to the next hole. Use of an unauthorised form of transportation must be discontinued immediately upon discovery that a breach has occurred. Otherwise the player is disqualified.

10. DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES.

A player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect his play (e.g. elevation changes, wind speed, etc), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3.

11. DRESS REGULATIONS

All competitors must conform to the published Mowbray Golf Club Dress Code.

12. TIES.

12.1 In the event of a tie or ties for the Championship, unless the Championship Committee determines otherwise, play shall continue over such holes as the Championship Committee shall decide, player being eliminated hole by hole as they fail to maintain equality with others, until the winner is determined.

12.2 In the event a player cannot be contacted, the Championship will be awarded to the player on the Course.

12.3 All other events will be decided by the Australian Count Back System.

13. GOLF AUSTRALIA HARD CARD.

The Golf Hard Card will be in effect throughout the Men's Senior Amateur Championship of Tasmania.

14. CODE OF CONDUCT.

All entrants assent to be bound by Golf Australia's Code of Conduct. A copy of the code is available at www.golfaustralia.org.au

15. NO SMOKING.

All competitors and caddies are subject to State Government laws prohibiting the smoking of cigarettes, cigars or the like during the course of any round played in a competition.



Mowbray Golf Club is an 18-Hole, Par-71, Championship course totalling 6001 metres in length, consisting of two long par-5's, three varied par-3's and thirteen beautiful par-4's in a picturesque setting around a number of water features. Both the 1st and 10th Tees are situated near the Clubhouse so it's easy to start your round on either the front or back nine. The Club Members, Staff and Volunteers constantly strive to improve the presentation of the Course and Facilities and are justly proud of the Club.
