



2019 VICTORIAN SECONDARY SCHOOLS GOLF EVENT – GENERAL INFORMATION

Modified Rules

1. Hole Lengths

Students will have the option of selecting their teeing ground;

Course White Tee - For boys looking to qualify through to the state finals (generally for students with a golf handicap and play regularly)

Course Red Tee - For girls looking to qualify through to the state finals (generally for students with a golf handicap and play regularly)

Junior Secondary - These tees are set at the start of most fairways and play a lot shorter than the two tees mentioned above.

Approximately

120M Par 3

250M Par 4

350M Par 5

2. Maximum Strokes per Hole

Once a player has double par on any hole, the ball must be lifted and the relevant score for that hole placed on the scorecard. Any deliberate attempt to hit the ball must be counted as a stroke. No further strokes are permitted on the hole (*division events only*)

3. Bunkers

After two shots in a bunker the player may pick up their ball and play it from the side of the bunker not closer to the hole. Should a player play directly from one bunker into another bunker then their next shot shall be deemed their second bunker shot. No extra penalty shot for placing the ball outside the bunker.

4. Lost Ball

If a ball is lost during play, a player must drop another ball at the point of entry to where the ball was lost under penalty of one shot.

Format

Students will play 9 holes on a short course during the Division Events. The State Final will be played over 18 holes on a full-length course.

Equipment

Golf Australia can provide a set of clubs for players if they don't have their own set. Students who have access to their own sets are encouraged to bring them along, including golf balls, tees, pencils etc

Clothing

All players, spectators and supervising staff must be appropriately dressed (School sport uniform is fine). Runners or golf shoes are appropriate foot wear for play.
