ABOUT THE MEN'S EVENTS

2019 MEN'S NSW MEDAL (STROKE PLAY)

The first stage of the Championship, known as the NSW Medal, will be stroke play over two rounds of 18 holes (36 holes), one round to be played at Terrey Hills Golf & Country Club and one to be played at Mona Vale Golf Club. The first round will be played on Monday 21 January and the second round on Tuesday 22 January. The field shall be divided between Terrey Hills Golf & Country Club and Mona Vale Golf Club on each of the first two days with players changing venues for the second round.

The leading player at the end of all stroke play rounds shall be the 2019 NSW Medallist.

2018 MEN'S NSW CLUB CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS (Stroke Play)

The 2018 NSW Club Champion of Champions event is played in conjunction with the NSW Medal. The event will be 36 holes of stroke play. The first round will be played on Monday 21 January at Terrey Hills Golf & Country Club and the second round on Tuesday 22 January at Mona Vale Golf Club.

The leading eligible player(s) at the end of the completed stroke play rounds shall be the 2018 Men's NSW Club Champion of Champions. In the event of a tie, joint winners will be declared.

2019 MEN'S NSW AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP (Match Play)

The leading 32 players (who have nominated to participate on their entry) will qualify for the match play stage of the Men's NSW Amateur Championship to be played at Terrey Hills Golf & Country Club from Wednesday 23 to Friday 25 January.

In the event of a tie such that more than 32 players have qualified, those players tying for the last qualifying position or positions will compete over such holes as the Championship Committee determines in a sudden-death play-off at Terrey Hills Golf & Country Club on Tuesday 22 January immediately following the second Round until 32 qualifiers have been determined.

Once the 32 players have been determined, for the purposes of determining places in the Match Play Draw, the "General Numerical Draw" published by Golf Australia will be used (i.e. the lowest qualifier is No 1, the second lowest No 2 and so on).

For the purposes of determining places in the Match Play Draw, ties at the end of the qualifying rounds other than those qualifying for the last place will be decided by a blind draw. The Draw for the first day's matches will be available online at www.golfnsw.org shortly after the 32 players are determined. Results and subsequent draws will also be available online at www.golfnsw.org.



ABOUT THE WOMEN'S EVENTS

2019 WOMEN'S NSW STROKE PLAY CHAMPIONSHIP

The Women's NSW Stroke Play Championship will be stroke play over two rounds of 18 holes (36 holes). The first round will be played on Monday 21 January at Terrey Hills Golf & Country Club, while the second round will be played on Tuesday 22 January at Mona Vale Golf Club.

The leading player at the end of all stroke play rounds shall be the 2019 Women's NSW Stroke Play Champion.

2019 WOMEN'S NSW AMATEUR CHAMPIONSHIP (Match Play)

The leading 16 players (who have nominated to participate on their entry) will qualify for the match play stage of the Women's NSW Amateur Championship to be played at Terrey Hills Golf & Country Club from Wednesday 23 to Friday 25 January.

In the event of a tie, such that more than 16 players have qualified, those players tying for the last qualifying position or positions will compete over such holes as the Championship Committee determines in a sudden-death play-off at Mona Vale Golf Club on Tuesday 22 January immediately following the second Round until 16 qualifiers have been determined.

Once the 16 players have been determined, for the purposes of determining places in the Match Play Draw, the "General Numerical Draw" published by Golf Australia will be used (i.e. the lowest qualifier is No 1, the second lowest No 2 and so on).

For the purposes of determining places in the Match Play Draw, ties at the end of the qualifying rounds other than those qualifying for the last place will be decided by a blind draw.

The Draw for the first day's matches will be available online at www.golfnsw.org shortly after the 16 players are determined. Results and subsequent draws will also be available online at www.golfnsw.org.

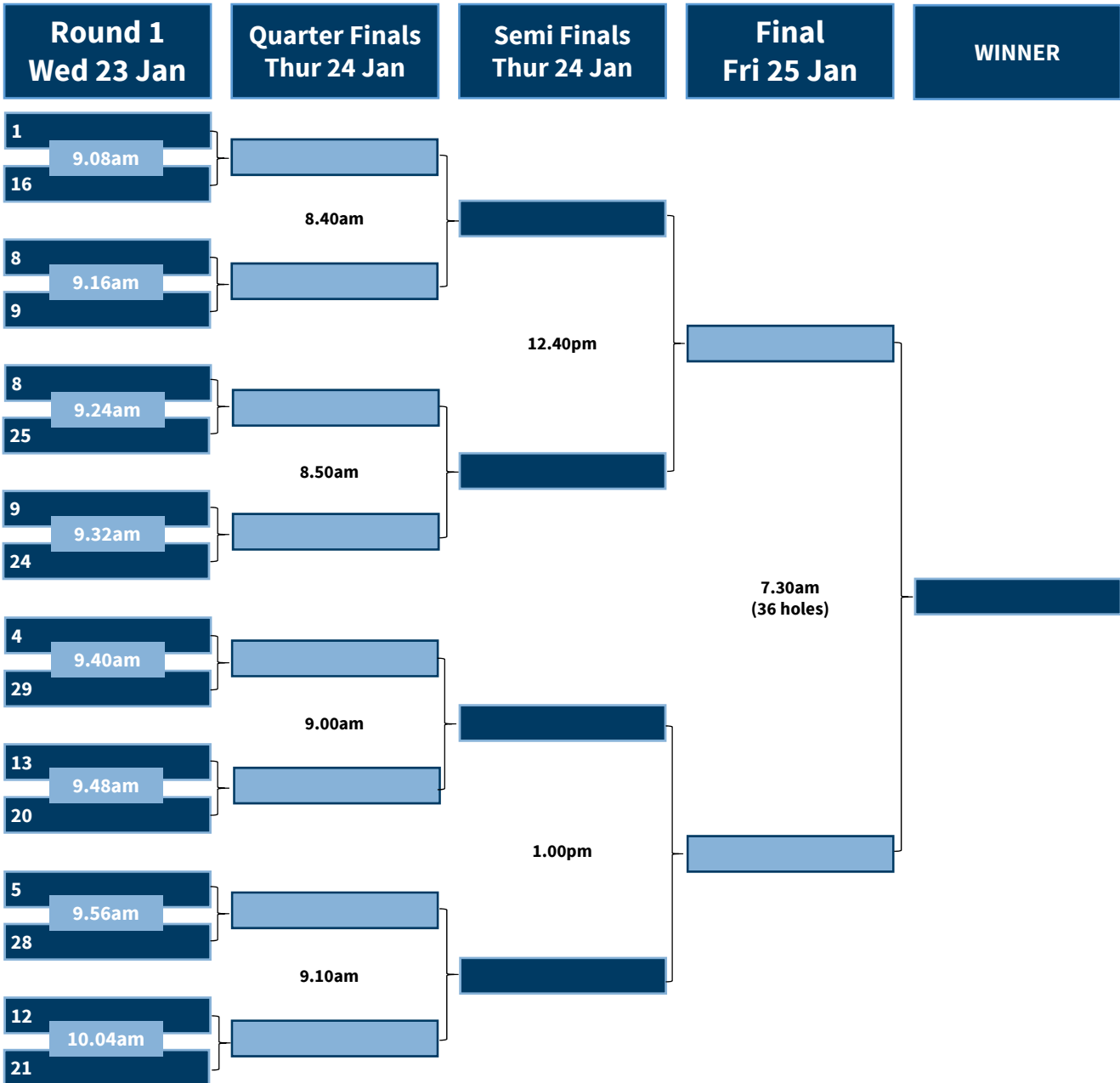

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

REGISTRATION

It is requested that all players register at least 30 minutes prior to their scheduled tee time at the club at which they are drawn. Registration will be in the clubhouse, and must be done each day prior to commencing play. Following this, report to the starter at least 15 minutes prior to your tee time. Your score card, pin positions and local rules will be given to you on the tee.

SCORE CARD RETURN AND SCORING

On completion of your round, please return your scorecard to the designated scorecard return area in the clubhouse. Live scoring will be displayed in the clubhouse, as well as being available online at www.golfnsw.org

QUALIFICATION FOR MATCH PLAY

All those that qualify for Match Play will be listed online at www.golfnsw.org. All match play draws will also be available online at the completion of play on Tuesday 22 January.

RULES OFFICIALS

There will be a number of roving rules officials on course on each day of play. Please utilise them if you need to.

USE OF MOTORISED CARTS

As per the conditions of entry, players may only use a motorised cart if a medical certificate is provided. This must be submitted to the Golf NSW office prior to the tournament. Bookings and payment for carts are the responsibility of the player.

PACE OF PLAY

Pace of play guidelines will apply to this event. Penalties may apply for breaches of the guidelines.

DRESS REGULATIONS

The dress regulations of Terrey Hills Golf & Country Club and Mona Vale Golf Club are available on the Golf NSW website. Please ensure you familiarise yourself with these requirements and comply. Players who fail to meet the required dress regulations will not be permitted to commence their round.

PRESENTATION

All presentations will be conducted at Terrey Hills Golf & Country Club at the completion of play on Friday 25 January. If you are able to attend these, please do so.

WITHDRAWAL

If you are unable to participate, please notify us immediately by emailing olivia.wilson@golfnsw.org. On presentation of a medical certificate a full refund will be issued, less an administration fee.

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

Distance Measuring Devices may be used in accordance with the Rules of Golf.

MOBILE PHONES

For the duration of the event, use of mobile phones are restricted to sending and receiving emails and messages only. You will be asked to leave the clubhouse should you make any calls on your mobile phone.



IMPORTANT INFORMATION

PLAYER AND CADDY RESPONSIBILITIES

All Players and Caddies must adhere to commonly accepted standards of golfing etiquette and sportsmanship.

Care of the course is an important aspect of etiquette.

Particular attention should be paid to the following:

- Repair divots, carry and use a sand bucket
- Repair pitch marks
- No smoking
- No consumption of alcohol

A breach may lead to disqualification under the Rules of Golf and/or disciplinary proceedings under the Code of Conduct.

A player is responsible for the actions of their caddy.
