CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. 18 holes of stroke play.
2. Open to male amateurs whose Golf Australia (GA) handicap does not exceed 4.5 and female amateurs whose GA handicap does not exceed 11.9.
3. The entrance fee must be paid at the time of entry, otherwise the entry cannot be accepted. No entries will be accepted by phone or email.
4. The Kooyonga Golf Club reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving an explanation. Any entrant may withdraw and have their entrance fee refunded provided notification is received prior to the date entries close.
5. The field will be strictly limited. In the event of entries exceeding this limit, a handicap ballot will apply; with entrants in the Golf SA Vardon Trophy afforded priority.
6. The Rules governing this event shall be the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club, St Andrews, Scotland, together with such local rules enforced by the Kooyonga Golf Club Inc.
7. Competitors must start at the appointed time.
8. The Match Committee of the Kooyonga Golf Club will make playing arrangements and be umpire in the case of a dispute or protest which must be lodged in writing with the Match Committee at the Clubhouse not later than 5 minutes after the conclusion of the day's play.
9. In the event of a tie there will be a sudden death playoff using the following sequence of holes: 1, 13, 14, 18 and repeated if necessary.
10. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group in front. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. Penalties will be applied to players in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to imposition of penalties.
11. Golf Australia conditions in relation to Code of Conduct apply.
12. **Players and caddies are expected to observe the dress standards and any course requirements of Kooyonga Golf Club.**
