# Conditions of Play

## **1. Rules**

The rules of golf adopted by the Royal and Ancient Club and the local rules of the Ocean Shores Country Club will be the rules of play during the event.

## **2. Handicaps Limits**

- a. 18 Hole Competition: All players use Golf Australia Handicaps and must provide proof of their handicap. Nett events will use Daily Handicaps;
- b. 9 Hole Competition: Boys – 36 and Girls – 36;

## **3. Play**

- a. Play is to be in groups of four for 18-hole competition and groups of three 9-hole competitions, where possible;
- b. Players must report to the starter 10 minutes prior to hit off time;
- c. Competitors not ready to start will automatically be inserted where there is a vacancy or placed at the end of the field where possible;
- d. Both the 5 and 9-hole competitions must use the 10 shot maximum rule. Once the player has played 10 shots they must proceed to the green, placing their ball and putting out from there

## **4. Ties**

- a. In the event of a tie for the 18-hole Junior Boys and Girls Gross events, a sudden death playoff will commence from the 10th hole through to 18th hole. If there is still a tie, the playoff will continue by repeating the 18th hole until a winner is determined.
- b. All other events will be decided by count back.

## **5. Disputes and protests**

- a. Disputes and protests are to be in writing to the Match Committee not later than 15 minutes after the finish of the round.
- b. Suspensions of play will be signified by continuous short blasts of an electric hooter. Players should mark the place where their ball lies and await further instructions.

## **6. Caddies**

Caddies will only be permitted for the 5 and 9 hole events. No 18 hole competitor 12 years and over will be allowed a caddy. Competitors 11 Years & Under are permitted bag pushers/helpers to assist with speed of play.

## **7. Control**

The Match Committee will be in charge of the event and their decision is final.

Entries Close – Thursday, 26th February 2019 but late entries may be taken.
