

2019 JGQ 18 Hole Points Challenge Series

Conditions of Tournament

- Players must be financial members of Junior Golf Queensland
- Players must have a current Golf Australia Handicap and be under 18 years of age as at the last Points Challenge event for 2019 to be eligible to win the Points Challenge Series. Players must have a current Golf Australia Handicap and be under 18 years of age to compete in a daily event
- Players must compete in at least 4 of the 7 Points Challenge events listed, to be eligible for the Points Challenge Series title. *(If competed in all 7 events the worst 3 rounds will be dropped)*
- Points Challenge Series title winners (Boy/Girl) will receive an invitation to play the 2019 Greg Norman Junior Masters
- Handicap divisions at each event are calculated based on daily handicaps, there will be 3 Divisions for Boys and 2 Divisions for Girls *(the division split may vary at each event depending on numbers and handicap range of participants)*
- Points will be allocated per overall place getter (Boy/Girl) at each event (not allocated in divisions) as follows:

1 st = 10 points	6 th = 5 points
2 nd = 9 points	7 th = 4 points
3 rd = 8 points	8 th = 3 points
4 th = 7 points	9 th = 2 points
5 th = 6 points	10 th onwards = 1 points
- If there is a tie for a place, the same number of points will be awarded to each player
- The Points Challenge Series title winner (Boy/Girl) will be decided by the most points attained from their stableford scores over the best 4 of 7 rounds. *(Trophies will be awarded at the end of the Series to Boy/Girl 1st to 3rd placed. If there is a tie for the Points Challenge Series title winner, the winner will be determined from these tied players by the total of points scored in the overall Challenge Series. If still tied, the winner will be determined by the player who had the most points in the last event both players competed. If still tied, the player who scored the best stableford points on a countback in the last event both players competed will win the overall Series title)*
- Daily prizes will be awarded based on stableford scores to the overall winner (Boy/Girl), as well as divisional winner and runner up (Boy/Girl) *(if there is a tie, the winner will be decided on using the countback system - back 9, back 6, back 3 holes)*
- The Tournament Committee appointed by Junior Golf Queensland shall have sole control of the tournament with the power to alter or vary any of the conditions, at any time, including scheduling another day or venue should it be deemed necessary. The tournament Committee's decision on all matters affecting the Tournament shall be final
- The Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews shall apply together with any local rules.

Rules as approved by the Tournament Committee

- A player can only win one prize at each Points Challenge event (excluding NTP's)
- Caddies are permitted during the Points Challenge Series, but any serious breach of caddy duties may result in a person no longer being allowed to carry out this duty
- Competitors may not travel in or on any motorised vehicle during any round of the Points Challenge Series, unless authorised by the Tournament Committee. Breach of this rule will result in a two-stroke penalty for each hole up to a maximum penalty of 4 strokes per round

- The use of mobile phones by players, caddies or spectators is strictly prohibited in the precincts of the golf course. Exception to rule: Distance measuring device or in case of an emergency
- Evidence of current handicap is to be produced at time of entry of each Points Challenge event
- Pace of play – Rule 5.6 will be strictly enforced. If a player cannot score on a hole they must pick up and record a wiper for that hole
- Smoking and the consumption of alcohol is prohibited by any player and/or caddy during any round, including in and around the clubhouse for players.
- **A penalty for failure to cancel from any one of the series events will apply unless a genuine reason/s is forthcoming. (2 points deducted from overall points total will be enforced).**
