COMPETITOR INFORMATION

REGISTRATION

Competitors must register at the Tournament Office between 10.00am and 4.00pm at Ulverstone Golf Club on either Tuesday 26 or Wednesday 27 February. Failure to comply with this condition may result in disqualification.

GENERAL COURSE CARE

The members of Ulverstone Golf Club have generously provided their course so that we can conduct this year's championship.

Please endeavour to replace your divots, rake bunkers and repair your plug marks so that the course can be returned to Ulverstone Golf Club and the members in its original condition at the conclusion of the tournament.

PRACTICE

The course will be open for practice on Monday 25 and Tuesday 26 November. Please contact the Ulverstone Golf Club office on (03) 6425 2322 to arrange a tee time. Course staff have the right of way at all times.

Competitors in the 2019 Men's & Women's Tasmanian Open Golf Championships are requested to report to the Ulverstone Golf Club office before practicing on the course or facilities. During a practice round, competitors are only permitted to use a maximum of two balls.

PULL BUGGIES

Please advise the Ulverstone Golf Club office if you require a pull buggy during the event. All cradles MUST be returned daily.

MOBILE PHONES

The use of mobile phones during the 2019 Men's & Women's Tasmanian Open Golf Championships is strictly prohibited. However, should you require a ruling or an emergency arises and a tournament official is not readily available please contact 0447 292 554 or 0409 539 144.

PACE OF PLAY

Rule 5.6b will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. A pace of play sheet will be produced and provided to each competitor.
