## Latrobe Junior Open Terms of Competition

1. The Latrobe Junior Open Tournament will be played on Thursday $11^{\text {th }}$ April 2019 over 18 holes stroke play.
2. A maximum field of 120 players will be eligible to compete in the event. In the event of entries exceeding 120 the Club reserves the right to take entries according to the date received.
3. The Entry Fee must be paid at the time of entry. Refunds will only be given to competitors who withdraw prior to Monday $8^{\text {th }}$ April 2019 @ 12.00pm.
4. Entrants shall be male and female amateurs under 21 years of age as at $11^{\text {th }}$ April 2019 who are Members of Clubs affiliated with Golf Australia or of Clubs registered with such State or Overseas Associations as are affiliated with or recognised by Golf Australia or of Clubs affiliated with the Victorian Golf League. The Club has the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
5. The tournament shall be under the management and control of the Tournament Committee. The Tournament Committee shall be appointed by the Latrobe Golf Club Match Committee. Membership of the Tournament Committee will be published on the day of the tournament.
6. The Tournament Committee shall have full power to alter or vary conditions of the program and shall decide the manner in which ties will be decided. In the case of a tie for the winner of the 18 Hole Gross event, unless the Tournament Committee decides otherwise, play shall continue over such holes as the Tournament Committee directs until a winner is determined.

In the event that no play-off is required to determine the winner, where two or more players have the same second-lowest gross score after 18 holes, the Runner Up will be determined by the Australian Countback System.

In the event that a play-off is required to determine the winner, and three or more players have the same lowest gross score after 18 holes, the Runner Up will be determined by a countback for players with the same score on the final hole of a playoff. Other ties will be decided by the Australian Countback System.
7. No competitor shall be permitted to win more than one trophy.
8. Players to report in by at least 7:30am.
9. The competition shall be played in accordance with the Rules of Golf as adopted by R\&A, together with such local rules that are in force on the course over which the competition rounds are being played. If a dispute arises it shall be decided by the Tournament Committee whose decision shall be final. If the committee is in doubt they have the right to refer any such dispute to the Golf Victoria whose decision shall be final.
10. Any protest regarding a result must be lodged with the Club not later than fifteen (15) minutes after completion of the round.
