2019 VICTORIAN MEN'S PAR 3 CHAMPIONSHIP – CHAMPIONSHIP CONDITIONS

(To be read in conjunction with the [Golf Australia Hard Card](#))

1. COMPETITION PROCEDURE

- 1.1 The Victorian Men's Par 3 Championship will be played over 54 Holes stroke play, 36 holes on Saturday and 18 holes on Sunday.
- 1.2 The field for the Championship will be limited to 90 players. In the instance the number of entries exceeds the maximum field capacity, a ballot will be undertaken with players on the **highest GA handicaps at the close of entries subject to elimination**. Sponsor entries shall be excluded from the ballot. Unsuccessful entries will be informed without delay and given the opportunity to compete if withdrawals subsequently occur.
- 1.3 Handicap divisions will be determined by Golf Australia at close of entries and are subject to change.
- 1.4 Players must play from their current handicap during the Championship, with the exception that no player shall play from a GA handicap greater than the maximum limit of 27.6 (Daily H'cap of 22).
- 1.5 The player recording the lowest 54 Hole gross score will be the Victorian Men's Par 3 Champion.
- 1.6 In the event of a tie for the Championship, a play-off shall determine the winner. The play-off will be played at a time and in a manner as decided by the Championship Committee. Ties for all other positions shall be decided by count-back as recommended by Golf Australia.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 Eligible players are male amateurs whose Golf Australia Handicap at the time of entry does not exceed 27.6 strokes in accordance with the Australian Handicapping System.
- 2.2 Entries will be restricted to amateurs, who are members of Victorian affiliated clubs, or of golf clubs registered with such State or Overseas Associations as are affiliated with or recognised by the Association, or of clubs affiliated with the Victorian Golf League and Registered Golfers.
- 2.3 Eligible players for all junior trophies must be under 18 years of age as of Saturday 8 June 2019.

3. ENTRIES

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$75.00 (incl. GST). Entry fee includes light lunch on both days.
- 3.2 Entries shall only be made on the official entry form or online at www.golf.org.au/victoria.
- 3.3 Golf Australia shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- 3.4 The draw for the competition will be sent to players and available at www.golf.org.au/victoria approximately one week before the event.

4. TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded for:

- **Best 54-Hole Overall Gross** – Victorian Men's Par 3 Champion & Runner-Up
- **Best 54-Hole Gross (H'Cap Divisions)** – Winners
- **Best 54-Hole Nett (H'Cap Divisions)** – Winners
- **Best 18-Hole Nett (H'Cap Divisions)** – Daily Winners
- **Best Junior (U18) Gross & Nett**
- **Overall Gross & Nett Teams' Event** – lowest overall aggregate gross & nett scores – teams of 3
- **Daily NTPs**
- **First Hole-in-One** (set of car tyres)

Players may win a maximum of one 54-hole trophy and one daily trophy (excl. Teams' event and NTP)

5. CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE

The Committee shall consist of representatives of the Kyabram Parkland Golf Club and Golf Australia. In the absence of a full Championship Committee, such members thereof, as may be present at the time, may give a decision so given shall be deemed to be a decision of the full Championship Committee.

In the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, the Championship Committee may shorten the competition, appoint another day or days for completion of, or may transfer play to another course. Protests must be made to the Championship Committee not later than 10 minutes after the conclusion of each round.

6. REFUND POLICY

Any entrant may withdraw and have their entry fee refunded provided notification is received within **three working days** prior to the commencement of the event. Under no circumstances will entry fees be refunded after this date unless players can provide Golf Australia supporting documents regarding their withdrawal from the event (ie. Medical Certificate).

7. MOTORISED TRANSPORT

According to GA's standard conditions of competitions, it is the responsibility of the player, if they require the use of a golf cart during the event to send a Medical Certificate and a completed copy of the Golf Australia Motorised Transport Approval Return Form for consideration by the Match Committee. Please go to the GA - Victorian website under *Championships & Events* → *Event Resources* → *Motorised Transport* for the return form and more information.

Exemption: Players aged 75 years and over do not require a Medical Certificate

Note: Golf carts are not available for hire at the venue. Players may bring their own carts.

8. DATABASE OF COMPETITORS DETAILS

The personal data contained in this entry is permanently retained by Golf Australia. This data may be utilised by Golf Australia or its sponsors for the distribution of correspondence, in both electronic and hard copy means. From time to time players may be sent entry forms, event literature, the Golf Australia e-newsletter, or marketing material by the sponsor(s) of Golf Australia events, or information about events conducted by Golf Australia-approved bodies. Upon receipt by Golf Australia of a written request, a player may either have access to their details, or have their details deleted from the database.
