TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

1. Format – Individual Championship, Teams Event & Sub Jnr

- 1.1 Played over 36 holes, 18 holes stroke play each day.
- 1.2 In the event of a tie, a sudden death hole by hole play-off will be conducted (as decided by the Match Committee). Ties for other place getters will be decided by countback.
- 1.3 Sub Junior participation event to be played over 9 holes each day. Course length to be set up at approximately 50% of original measurement. No prior registration required.

2. Teams Event

- 2.1 Each Country District will nominate a minimum of 3 and a maximum of 4 players to represent their District. Team members must be nominated prior to the commencement of Round 1. Any player who is a member with playing rights of a country club within that District may represent their District Team irrespective of where their handicap is held.
- 2.2 Format The best three of the four nominated daily scores to count. The winning team will be determined by the lowest aggregate of the combined scores over the two rounds.
- 2.3 In the case of a tie the winner will be decided by count back in the following gross score order: round 2, round 1, back nine round 2.

3. Handicaps

3.1 Players to use their round 1 daily handicap for the 36 holes.

4. Match Committee

- 4.1 The Match Committee will comprise the GA(SA) Match Committee.
- 4.2 In the absence of the full Match Committee, such members as may be present at the time, may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Match Committee.
- 4.3 The Match Committee will have the sole management and control of the event, with full power at any time to alter or vary any one of the Conditions.
- 4.4 The Match Committee's decision on matters affecting the event will be final.
- 4.5 Any dispute or protest must be made to the Match Committee not more than 15 minutes after the conclusion of play on the day on which the disputed matter has arisen.

5. Rules of Play

5.1 The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R & A Rules Limited, will apply together with Local Rules of the venue Club.

6. Entries

- 6.1 Eligible players for the event are junior boy and girl amateur golfers who are members of Golf Clubs affiliated with Golf Australia or overseas associations as are affiliated with or recognised by this association and who satisfy the necessary handicap and age qualifications.
- 6.2 The entry fee for the event is \$20.00 (including GST) and must be paid at the time of registration.
- 6.3 Registrations must be made via the GA (SA) online registration system. Entries by any other method will not be accepted.
- 6.4 Players must register by 5:00pm on Monday 22 April 2019. IT IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT THEMSELVES TO ENSURE THAT THEY HAVE REGISTERED CORRECTLY. A player has not officially registered until their name is listed in the 'Registered Participants' section of the event registration page.
- 6.5 The decision of the Match Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.
- 6.6 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Match Committee.

7. Conforming Golf Balls and Conforming Driver Heads

7.1 The specimen conditions in the Rules of Golf are in effect as regards Conforming Golf Balls and Conforming Driver Heads.

8. Drug Testing

8.1 All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Agency for banned substances as laid down in Golf Australia's Anti-Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy, or refusing to take a test, will be disqualified and subject to any sanction(s) brought down by ASADA.

9. Mobile Phones

9.1 Except in case of emergency, mobile phones must not be used to make or receive calls or messages when on the golf course.

10. Pace of Play

10.1 Rule 5-6 will be strictly enforced. A player must not unreasonably delay play, either when playing a hole or between two holes.

11. Caddies

11.1 Caddies are permitted for players aged 13 years and under as at the first day of competition. Caddies are not permitted for players aged 14 years and above as of the first day of competition.

12. Motorised Transport

12.1 Ride-on buggies will be permitted only on medical evidence and by permission of the venue club. Applications and approvals to be forwarded to Golf Australia – SA at time of registration. Caddies are not permitted to use ride on buggies.

13. Code of Conduct

13.1 All entrants assent to be bound by Golf Australia Code of Conduct. A copy of the Code is available at <u>www.golf.org.au</u>

14. Smoking

14.1 Players and caddies are prohibited from smoking cigarettes, cigars or the like (including e-cigarettes) during a stipulated round. See Golf Australia Code of Conduct.

15. Measuring Devices

15.1 A player may obtain distance only information by use of a distance measuring device.

16. Draw

16.1 Tee times will be available on the Golf Australia – SA website www.golf.org.au/golfsa from Monday 29th April 2019.

17. Photography

17.1 By entering the event, you agree to having your photo taken and potentially published on social media.
