**2019 BRIDGES REDLAND BAY GOLF CLUB CENTENARY OPEN:** 1. The Competition is a 18 hole Stroke Event open to Men, Women and Juniors who have a Golf Australia Handicap. 2. The Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and Golf Australia and the local rules of the Redland Bay Golf Club will be the rules of play for the tournament. 3. The Tournament Committee controls the tournament and shall be the absolute umpire in any dispute or protest. The Committee shall have the power to reject any entry. 4. The Tournament Committee shall have the right to determine eligibility for entry into the tournament. 5. The Tournament Committee may, in the event of bad weather or for any reason, either shorten any contest or fix another day for play. 6. Handicap limit for Men is 36 and for Women is 45 (Grades after slope rating applied) Men – A Grade; 0-10, B Grade; 11-17, C Grade 18-36. Women A Grade; 0-18, B Grade; 19-29, C Grade; 30-45. 7. Minimum \$2,000 in prizes, Gross and Nett for all Grades, nearest the Pins on par 3's 8. Motorised Golf Carts will be allowed during the event. Bookings must be made through the Pro-Shop on (07) 3246 8143. 9. Competitors MUST report to the Pro-Shop at least 30 minutes prior to their designated tee off time. The Tournament Committee will have the power to alter the draw, subject to the availability of players. 10. A competitor wishing to enter a protest shall do so in writing which he or she will lodge with the Tournament Committee of the Redland Bay Golf Club not later than 15 minutes after they have completed their round. 11. No Player may win more than 1 major trophy. 12. In the event of a tie in any Grade (Men & Women) the winner will be decided by a countback system as designated by the Tournament Committee.
