# **GENERAL INFORMATION**

# Registration

All competitors are required register in the Kooringal Clubhouse upon arrival at the course at **least 30 minutes** before their tee time.

# **Handicaps & Scoring**

All players must ensure that their current and correct handicap is recorded on the scorecard. 6-2b. Players must play from their current **DAILY** handicap during the Championship.

# Scorecards

All score cards are to be scanned at the Kiosk situated in the clubhouse immediately at the conclusion of play.

# **Dress Regulations**

All **players and caddies** are required to adhere to the Club's dress regulations with particular reference to the following: -

- Clean dress shoes MUST be worn in the clubhouse at all times. Athletic jogger type shoes are not permitted.
- Advertising or display materials must not appear on clothing except for brand name logos.
- All shirts must have a collar.
- Tailored shorts are permitted.
- Denim clothing of any description is not permitted.

## Footwear

Players are requested to note that soft spikes are mandatory.

# **Course Care/Club Regulations**

Players are reminded that sand buckets **MUST** be taken and used, pitch marks are to be repaired, and bunkers raked the following play at each course. Mobile phones are not to be used in the clubhouse or on the course unless in the case of an emergency or a ruling during the round. Play will be from the nominated tee markers.

## Slow Play

Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course on the group preceding them. Any group with a clear hole in front of them will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to pairs in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued before penalties.

# Suspension of Play

In the event of heavy rain, lightning or for any other reason, the Championship Committee will be responsible for deciding whether to suspend play. The signal for suspending play will be one short siren blast. The procedure when play is suspended is outlined under Rule 6-8b. When the course is ready for play, players will be advised to return to various locations. The signal for the resumption of play will be one long siren blast.

# **ENTRY CONDITIONS**

- 1. Entrance Fee MUST be paid at the time of entry. All registrations are to be made through the online portal at www.golf.org.au/victoria
- 2. Entrants shall be amateurs who are Members of Clubs of Golf Victoria or of Clubs registered with such State or Overseas Associations as are affiliated with or recognised by Victorian Clubs affiliated with the Victorian Golf League and Registered Golfers and the Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- 3. In the event of bad weather or for any other reason, the Committee may either shorten the contest or fix another day.
- 4. Ties in handicap events will be decided by countback. Ties in scratch events will be decided by sudden death play-off played from 10,11,12,18 until a winner is found.
- 5. The Competitions shall be played by the Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews, Scotland, together with such Local Rules as are in force on the course over which the Competition takes place.
- 6. If a dispute arises at any point, it shall be decided by the Committee in charge of the Competition whose decision shall be final. However, the Committee in doubt shall have the right o refer any such dispute to Golf Australia whose decision shall then be final.
