2019 ROSANNA JUNIOR OPEN – TOURNAMENT CONDITIONS

1. GENERAL

- 1.1 The Open will be played over 18 holes on Wednesday 10th of July 2019 at the Rosanna Golf Club.
- 1.2 The field for the Open will be limited to 120 players
- 1.3 With consideration to the provisions of condition 1.2 above, entries will be accepted on a receipt of entry basis until a capacity field is achieved.

2. ELIGIBILITY

- 2.1 Eligible players are male & female amateurs who are aged under 18 as at 10th of July 2019 and who hold a current Golf Australia Handicap.

3. ENTRIES

- 3.1 The entry fee is \$35.00 (inc. GST). Entry fee must be paid at the time of entry.
- 3.2 The field will be limited to 120 players
- 3.3 There will be a limit to 20 boys and 10 girls in each age section. After these spots have been filled, entries will be on an emergency list. If other age sections aren't filled the Open Committee will fill these spots from the emergency list.
- 3.4 The Open Committee shall have the right to refuse the entry of any person without being required to give any reason for such refusal.
- 3.5 Entries shall only be made through golfbox found on the golf Australia website.
- 3.6 The draw for the competition will be sent to players and will be available at www.golf.org.au and www.rosannagolf.com.au.

4. TROPHIES

- 4.1 The male and female player with the lowest stroke score after 18 holes shall be the 2019 Boys and Girls Rosanna Junior Open Champions respectively and shall receive a trophy.
- 4.2 The male and female player with the lowest nett score after 18 holes shall be the 2019 Boys & Girls Rosanna Junior Open Handicap Champions respectively and shall receive a trophy.
- 4.3 The respective Boys & Girls who are runners-up in the stroke play section and the handicap section shall also receive a trophy.

4.4 The male and female players with the lowest stroke and nett scores after 18 holes in the following age groups shall also receive trophies:

- Under 18 (Boys & Girls)
- Under 16 (Boys & Girls)
- Under 14 (Boys & Girls)
- Under 12 (Boys & Girls)

4.5 Ties for any stroke or handicap event shall be decided by Golf Australia count back.

4.6 No player may win more than one trophy in the overall 18-hole stroke and nett sections. However, a player may win one additional trophy in his or her age group section.

5. OPEN COMMITTEE

5.1 The Open Committee shall consist of representatives of the Rosanna Golf Club and Golf Australia. In the absence of the full Open Committee, present members of the committee at any time may give a decision and any decision shall be deemed the decision of the full Open Committee.

The Open Committee reserves the right to vary any condition of this event. In the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, the Open Committee may shorten the competition or appoint another day. The decision of the Open Committee will be final in all matters relating to the Tournament.

6. HEAT POLICY

6.1 The Golf Australia Heat Policy shall apply for the duration of the event.

7. DATABASE OF COMPETITORS DETAILS

7.1 Golf Australia and Rosanna Golf Club will take photographs of players, caddies and spectators participating in this event. In entering this event the player and parents understand that Golf Australia and Rosanna Golf Club retains the right to use images taken during this tournament.
