

2019 GOLF AUSTRALIA ORDERS OF MERIT:

(Conditions for Determining Final Placings)

Preamble

These conditions relate to the determination of the winner, place getters and other positions for the 2019 Golf Australia Orders of Merit (GA OOM) upon the conclusion of the GA OOM period.

1. Eligibility

- 1.1 For players to accrue points towards their respective 2019 GA OOM, at a GA OOM event, they must meet each of the following conditions at the time of the GA OOM event:
 - Be an amateur golfer holding a current Golflink Number
 - Conform in all respects to the Rules of Amateur Status as approved by R&A Rules Ltd.
- 1.2 Players who breach the Golf Australia Code of Conduct or the Golf Australia Anti-Doping Policy may incur penalties which could impact upon their capacity to accrue GA OOM points. Players in breach of either the Code of Conduct or the Anti-Doping Policy may be removed from the GA OOM. Any decision relating to condition 1.2 will be in the sole purview of Golf Australia.
- 1.3 The decision of Golf Australia as to acceptance or refusal of a player's results from GA OOM events for the GA OOM is final.

2. General

- 2.1 Golf Australia will have the sole management and control of the GA OOM, with full power at any time to alter or vary any of the Conditions.
- 2.2 The OOM will be administered through the Golfbox Tournament management system. For events utilising other management systems, the results for the OOM will be sourced through Golflink. It is the responsibility of the tournament administrators to make sure the results are uploaded to Golflink in a timely manner.
- 2.3 Golf Australia's decision on matters affecting the GA OOM will be final.

3. Determining the Winner and Other Finishing Positions

- 3.1 A player's ranking will be determined by totalling all points gained from GA OOM events played.
- 3.2 After 3.1 has been executed, the player with the greatest number of points accrued from GA OOM events played between 1 November 2018 and 31 October 2019 will be the winner of the 2019 GA OOM. There is no minimum or maximum number of events that must be played to win or gain a place in the GA OOM.
- 3.3 The 1st, 2nd and 3rd place getters will receive a gold, silver and bronze Golf Australia Medallion respectively. In the case of ties, joint winners will be awarded.
- 3.4 A player remains eligible to win the 2019 GA OOM if for example they turn professional between 1 November 2018 and 31 October 2019 as any legitimately accrued points (as per condition 1.1) will remain 'live' until the end of the GA OOM period.



4. GA OOM Events and Points Tables

- 4.1 The events listed in the appendices are the GA OOM events for the GA OOM. Each event includes its weighting. Points will be awarded to each finishing position based on a percentage breakdown of the total points allocated to each event (based on the weighting) for Stroke Play and Match Play. This breakdown mirrors the points allocation from previous years.
- 4.2 The event weighting is based on the customary strength of the field and the status of the event. Golf Australia will review event weightings from time to time.
- 4.3 If the number of rounds of an GA OOM Event is reduced, the following points will be allocated:
 - An event reduced from 72 holes to 54 holes: no change
 - An event reduced from 54 holes to 36 holes: no change
 - An event reduced from 72 holes to 36 holes: the points weighting is reduced by 1 level
 - An event reduced to 18 holes: the points weighting is reduced to level 1
- 4.4 Events comprising stroke play rounds followed by match play rounds are considered TWO events with respect to the number of events played.
- 4.5 Where an event has more than one Grade/Division (e.g. A Grade, B Grade, etc) only scores from the A Grade players count for GA OOM purposes. Similarly in events where there are age divisions (as in many junior events) only the overall division scores will count for the GA OOM.
- 4.6 Where players finish in tied positions in GA OOM events, the points allocated to those finishing positions will be averaged and split evenly amongst the tied players. Exception: where there is a play-off to determine the winner, the winner of the play-off will be allocated the points for the first position.
- 4.7 If a player is disqualified from a GA OOM event, or fails to complete a round without reasonable justification (as determined by Golf Australia), the player will be deemed to have been disqualified which will result in 0 points being allocated.
- 4.8 a) All National, and State and Territory Championships are automatically granted GA OOM status. For additional events to be granted GA OOM status, the event must:
 - Be scheduled to be played over at least 54 holes; (36 holes minimum for Senior and Junior events), and
 - Must not discriminate against categories of players who are eligible for the relevant GA OOM (ie it cannot be restricted to players aged 25-40 years, for example)
 - Where it is a Nominated Event, it must meet the Regulations in respect to the payment of expenses for the Nominated Players. Should these Regulations not be met, the event may lose its Nominated Event status.
 - b) An event will be granted GA OOM status at the discretion of Golf Australia but must meet the minimum criteria outlined in 4.8a).
