*Participation in interstate events have limited John Davey's appearances in locally but he made his presence felt in this one but only by a stroke from six others all with 78's. Ken Parker's (Kooyonga) one-over back nine of 36 gave him second place and maintained his lead in the Senior Order of Merit. The unlucky others with 78 were John Keogh (Glenelg), Bruce Lindner (Kooyonga), Steve Ross (South Lakes), Nigel Turner (Links Lady Bay) and Trevor Smith (Naracoorte) – all the consistent performers in 2019 in what was a great contest.*

*Super Seniors saw another tight finish with 4 players tied on 84. Alan Cooper (Mt Osmond) on the count back from Michael Howard (Victor Harbor), Mike Richards (Tea Tree Gully) and Eric Lane (The Grange).*

*In the Nett events, Seniors went to Shane Virgo (Oakbank) 70 – clear winner from Parker, Keogh, John Zantvoort (Aston Hills) and local Jeff Downs. Super Seniors went to consistent West Lakes member, Malcolm Sangster (74), Cooper and Howard followed closely with 75's.*
