#### Terms of the Competition

#### 1. Format

- 1.1 The event will be played over 36 holes of stroke play.
- 1.2 In the event of a tie for the Championship, unless the Match Committee determines otherwise, a sudden death hole by hole play-off will be conducted (as decided by the Match Committee). Ties for other placegetters will be decided by countback.

#### 2. Entries

- 2.1 The event is open to male amateur golfers who are members of Golf Clubs affiliated with Golf Australia or overseas associations that are affiliated with or recognised by this association with maximum GA handicap of GA 27.4.
- 2.2 The Entrance Fee for the event is \$35.00 (including GST) and must be paid at the time of entry.
- 2.3 Entries must be made via the online registration system. Entries by any other method will not be accepted.
- 2.4 The decision of the Match Committee as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.
- 2.5 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Match Committee.
- 2.6 Players must register by **5.00pm on Monday 5<sup>th</sup> August 2019.** IT IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE ENTRANT THEMSELVES TO ENSURE THAT THEY HAVE REGISTERED CORRECTLY. A player has not officially registered until their name is listed in the **Registered Participants** section of the event registration page.
- 2.7 Entrance fees will only be refunded in the case of a withdrawal being advised before the closing time for entries.
- 2.8 The Match Committee reserves the right to determine the size of the field with a **maximum field size of 102 players**. If a ballot is required, the higher handicap competitors as at the closing date of registrations will be eliminated first. Unsuccessful entrants will be informed without delay. Entrance fees will be refunded to competitors balloted out.

#### 3. Handicaps

- 3.1 Eligible players for the A Division Championship are male amateur's whose GA Handicap or overseas equivalent does not exceed GA 12.9 as at the first day of play. Eligible players for the B Division Championship are male amateurs whose GA Handicap or overseas equivalent is GA 13.0 27.4 as at the first day of play.
- 3.2 The Match Committee has the right to alter the handicap divisions based on entries at anytime without notice
- 3.3 A player entering on the GA Handicap limit of 27.4 and who exceeds that GA Handicap before the first day of play will remain in the event playing on a maximum GA Handicap of 27.4
- 3.4 Players to play off their Daily Handicap as of the first day of play.

#### 4. Match Committee

- 4.1 The Match Committee will comprise the GA (SA) Match Committee.
- 4.2 In the absence of the full Match Committee, such members as may be present at the time, may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Match Committee.
- 4.3 The Match Committee will have the sole management and control of the event, with full power at any time to alter or vary any one of the Conditions.
- 4.4 The Match Committee's decision on matters affecting the event will be final.

- 4.5 Any dispute or protest must be made to the Match Committee not later than 15 minutes after the conclusion of play on the day on which the disputed matter has arisen.
- 4.6 The Match Committee may, in the event of bad weather or for any other reason, alter the venue, time or day of play.

#### 5. Rules of Play

5.1 The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R & A Rules Limited, will apply together with Local Rules of the venue club.

#### 6. Conforming Golf Balls & Conforming Driver Heads

6.1 The specimen conditions in the Rules of Golf are in effect as regards Conforming Golf Balls and Conforming Driver Heads.

#### 7. Drug Testing

7.1 All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Agency for banned substances as laid down in Golf Australia's Anti-Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy, or refusing to take a test, will be disqualified and subject to any sanction(s) brought down by ASADA.

#### 8. Smoking

8.1 Players are prohibited from smoking cigarettes, cigars, ecigarettes or the like during a stipulated round. See Golf Australia's Code of Conduct.

#### 9. Alcohol Consumption

9.1 Players are prohibited from consuming alcohol during a stipulated round. See Golf Australia's Code of Conduct.

#### 10. Mobile Phones

10.1 Except in case of emergency, mobile phones must not be used to make or receive calls or messages when on the golf course.

#### 11. Pace of Play

11.1 Rule 5-6 will be strictly enforced. A player must not unreasonably delay play, either when playing a hole or between two holes.

#### 12. Motorised Transport

12.1 Ride-on buggies will be permitted only on medical evidence and by permission of the venue Club. Applications and approvals to be forwarded to Golf Australia - SA at time of registration. Caddies are not permitted to use ride-on buggies.

#### 13. Measuring Devices

13.1 A player may obtain distance only information by use of a distance-measuring device.

#### 14. Code of Conduct

14.1 All entrants assent to be bound by Golf Australia's Code of Conduct. A copy of the Code is available at www.golf.org.au

#### 15. Draws

- 15.1 Competitors will be drawn in such manner as the Match Committee shall arrange. The Match Committee reserves the right to alter the draw without notice.
- 15.2 Tee times will be available www.golf.org/golfsa from Monday 12th August 2019.
