Tournament Conditions

1. The Event: The Warner Building Group Junior Age Masters will be played over three days from the 23rd September to the 25th September 2019. This will be a stroke event played 27 holes (6 years to 12 years) and 54 holes (13 years to 18 years). With prizes for 1st to 5th in each age division.

The Committee: Reserves the right reserves the right to:

(A) Fix / alter the starting times

(B) In the event of bad weather or any other reason shorten the contest or fix another

venue /date

- (C) Vary any condition should they be deemed it advisable
- (D) Reject any entry without assigning any reason therefore.
- 2. All players must be a financial member of a golf affiliated with the Golf Australia.
- 3. CHEATING, UNFITTING BEHAVIOUR, SWEARING: Any Player caught deliberately cheating will automatically be disqualified from the tournament.
- 4. **Smoking:** Smoking will not be permitted by any Junior player, caddy or parent during competition or within the clubhouse surrounds
- 5. Any player, Caddy, parent or guardian who disrupts play, abuses the course or behaves in a manor not becoming to the etiquette of the game of golf or to fellow competitors, Will be penalized as per Golf C Q YELLOW / RED card system and may be asked to appear before the Championship committee. with their parent/guardian to show cause why they should not be suspended from further championship events.
- 6. **RULES:** The Rules of Golf as adopted by the Royal & Ancient Golf Club of St. Andrews will apply, together with such Local Rules as are approved by the Championship Committee. See Below:
 - Pace of Play Rules 5.6a and 5.6b pages 36 & 37 of the Players Edition of the Rules of Golf
 - **Starting Times** Rule 5.3a page 35 of the Players Edition of the Rules of Golf.
 - Distance & Measuring Devices Rules 4.3a(1) & 4.3a(2) pages 67 & 68 Official Guide to the Rules of Golf
 - 7. CADDY: Parents are permitted to caddy for their child, but act within the Rules of Golf, this golf club and within the rules in these "Conditions of Play".

- 8. **PROTESTS**: All protest must be in writing and handed to the Championship Committee no later than 15 minutes after the conclusion of his or her round.
- 9. **MOBILE PHONES**: All players, caddies and parents must have their Mobile Phone switched off or on silent during each round.
 - 10. **PHOTOS**: Please ensure when taking photographs they are of your children only, and if you are posting them on a public site please ensure you block out any other competitors' images.
 - 11. AGE DIVISION DISTANCES: please not the table below approximates the distances for each age group.
