

# SA Junior Golf Par 3 Events

(for girls & boys aged 5yrs - 13yrs)

## School Holidays

Event 1 - Monday 30 September – Individual event

Event 2 - Tuesday 8 October – Team event

These par 3 events coordinated by Golf Australia are a steppingstone for those children looking for their first competitive on course golf experience.

Ideally children have or are currently participating in a MyGolf junior program at their local golf facility however beginners who have been exposed to golf at their school are also welcome to register

**Location:** North Adelaide Par 3 golf course  
(All holes between 56 to 140 metres in length)  
Located off War Memorial Drive, North Adelaide,  
Par 3 can be found at the end of the car park behind the River Café

**Format:**  
Monday 30 September: 9 Holes for players aged 5-9 years  
(Individual Event) 18 Holes for players aged 10-13 years  
Tuesday 8 October 9 Holes for players aged 5-9 years  
(Team Ambrose Event) 18 Holes for players aged 10-13 years  
Players register individually and will be drawn into teams.

9 hole players will be starting approx. between 10am-11am and will finish between 11.30am-12.30pm  
18 hole players will be starting approx. between 9am-10am and will finish between 11.30am-12.30pm

**Eligibility:** Boys & Girls aged between 5 and 13 years as at 30 Sep 2019  
No handicaps required for these events (they are non-handicapped events)

## Terms of the Competition

### 1. Competition Procedure

- 1.1. There are two events being played.
- 1.2. The first event will be an individual event played on Monday 30 September over 9 holes for players aged 5-9 years and 18 holes for players aged 10-13 years
- 1.3. The second event will be Team Ambrose event played on Tuesday 8 October over 9 holes for players aged 5-9 years and 18 holes for players aged 10-13 years

### 2. Eligibility

- 2.1. Eligible players are male and female amateurs aged between 5 and 13 years as at 30 Sep 2019.
- 2.2. No handicaps required for these events (they are non-handicapped event)

### 3. Entry Requirements

- 3.1. The Entrance Fee for each event is \$9.50 (includes GST) to be paid on the day to the pro shop.
- 3.2. Entries will be accepted via the Golf Australia – SA online entry system by the closing date.
- 3.3. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Golf Australia SA Development Team.
- 3.4. The decision of the Golf Australia SA Development Team as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.
- 3.5. Entrance fees will only be refunded in the case of a withdrawal being advised before the draws being made available on 5pm Mon 23 Sep and 5pm Wed 2 Oct.

### 4. Scoring rewards

- 4.1 This is a participation event. Scoring rewards will be awarded to players based on score range.

### 5. Championship Play Committee

- 5.1. The Golf Australia SA Development Team will have the sole management and control of the events, with full power at any time to alter or vary any of the conditions.
- 5.2. The Golf Australia SA Development Team's decision on matters affecting the events will be final.

### 6. Rules of Golf

- 6.1 Modified rules will be used for these events. Once a player has eight strokes on any hole, the ball must be lifted, with 8 placed against the relevant hole on the scorecard. No further strokes are permitted on the hole.

### 7. Caddies

- 7.1 Each group must be accompanied by an adult during the event whose responsibility include safety and scoring where necessary.

### 8. Draw

- 8.1. Event 1 – Draw available from 5pm Mon 23 Sep
- 8.2. Event 2 – Draw available from 5pm Wed 2 Oct

### 9. Database of Competitors' Details

- 9.1. The personal data contained in this entry is permanently retained by GA. This data may be utilised by GA or its sponsors for the distribution of correspondence, in both electronic and hard copy means. From time to time players may be sent entry forms, event literature, the GA e-newsletter, or marketing material by the sponsor(s) of GA events, or information about events conducted by GA approved bodies. Upon receipt by GA of a written request, a player may either have access to their details, or have their details deleted from the database.

### 10. Code of Conduct

- 10.1. All entrants are bound by GA's Code of Conduct ("the Code"). A copy of the Code is available at [golf.org.au](http://golf.org.au). Any breach of the Code may be recorded on the Central Register of the Code ("the Register"). The Register may be accessed (and published from time to time) by any State Association or GA for the purposes of administering Competitions or state championships, events, competitions, practice sessions or major activities conducted or sanctioned by a State Association, or any State Association or GA codes of conduct and/or other related matters.

### 11. Images

- 11.1. Golf Australia may arrange for promotion of the Championship, for radio, internet and television broadcasting and other exhibition and publication of the Championship or excerpts thereof in any and all media throughout the world, whether now known or hereafter developed. By this application, the player consents to the use by Golf Australia, or persons authorised by Golf Australia, of their name, likeness, voice and references to them and photographs and other images of them and their play connected with their appearance in the Championship, or any portion(s) thereof, in connection with such media promotion, broadcasting and other exhibition and publication of the Championship. Golf Australia may utilise the rights granted it hereunder in connection with the promotion of this Championship as well as other Golf Australia Championships and Golf Australia. The cooperation of players with authorised representatives of the media is required, provided that no pre-Championship activities outside of those activities which are part of the Championship will be required and provided that the player's Championship play is not unreasonably interfered with.
