CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. The Anne Smerdon Junior Girl's Invitational is open to all female junior golfers with an official Golf Australia handicap of 30 or less, and who are under 21 years of age on Sunday, 13th October 2019.
2. The Glenelg Golf Club Girl's Junior Championship is open to all female junior members of the Club who are under 18 years of age on Sunday, 13th October 2019.
3. The event is an 18-hole stroke play championship.
4. In the event of a tie after 18 holes for all events, the winner shall be decided on a Countback over the last 9, 6, 3, and last hole.
5. Trophies will be awarded for the following:
 - Anne Smerdon Trophy
 - Winner of Gross Event
 - Runner-up Best Gross
 - Winner of Net Event
 - Glenelg Golf Club Junior Girl's Championship
 - Winner of Gross Event
 - Runner-up Best Gross
 - Winner of Net Event (Ella Cole)
6. The Match Committee will make all arrangements and shall have the full power to alter or make any variations to the conditions should it be deemed necessary. The Match Committee is the absolute umpire of any disputes or protests.
7. The entrance fee must be paid at the time of entry, otherwise the entry form will not be accepted. No entries will be accepted by phone without payment by credit card. Late entries will not be accepted.
8. The use of motorised ride-on buggies by competitors and/or their caddies is prohibited.
9. Any competitor who is not on the tee and ready to start at the appointed time shall be disqualified in accordance with Rule 6-3.
10. Competitors must play with a ball that is named in the current R&A and/or USGA approved lists.
