#### **Divisions**

Colts - Under 21 boys and girls (born between 1998 and 2000) Class A - Under 18 boys and girls (born between 2001 and 2003) Class B - Under 15 boys and girls (born in 2004 or later)

The Championship, ratified as a world ranking event by the R & A, will be open to boys and girls under the age of 21 as of 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018. There will be 1 x 12 month scholarship and 4 x 1 month scholarships on offer to attend Hills Educational Foundation and Hills Golf Academy to players who have indicated on the entry form their acceptance of such and that the players meet the scholarship criteria.

#### **CONDITIONS**

- 1. Organizer Asia Pacific Junior Golf Association Organizing Committee
- **2. Venue and Dates –** Hills Golf Club, 4 Johanna St, Jimboomba, Queensland. 4280. Practice round 25<sup>th</sup> November, Tournament dates 26<sup>th</sup> November to 28<sup>th</sup> November 2019
- 3. Eligibility The tournament is open to all golfers who are under the age of 21 as at the 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018. Players eligible may have a handicap that will not exceed 16.4 for boys and 24.4 for girls at the time of entry. Players with higher handicaps may be considered depending on tournament entries.
- **4. Size of the field -** The Tournament field is restricted to 120 players with the split up of age groups to be determined by the Organizing committee. Should entries be received in excess of 120 players, non-exempt players with higher handicaps will be balloted out and their entry fee will be refunded.
- **5.** Manner of play 54 holes stroke play competition
- **6. Draw and starting times** A draw for each days play will be published on the Hills Golf Academy and Hills Golf Club websites. The draw for the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> rounds will be an automatic draw determined on the scores returned from previous rounds.
- 7. Tees Determined by the Organizing Committee
- 8. Awards –. The overall winner and runner-up prizes to be awarded to boys and girls in all divisions. Other prizes will be awarded as determined by the organizing committee. Players who have indicated that they wish to be considered for a scholarship offer must comply with the following criteria:
  - Outstanding performances in selected golf tournaments
  - The candidate must show solid character traits acceptable to the College
  - The candidate must show a quality of personal appearance and general presentation
  - The candidate must have a C+ average as a minimum requirement of academic skills
  - The candidate must have general golf playing skills at an elevated level as deemed by the selection committee
  - If the candidate is an international student, they must fulfill The Australian Government's Department of Immigration student visa requirements
  - The scholarship offer is valid for 12 months, student must activate this by 2020
- **9. Ties –** Tie for the overall winner will be decided by a sudden death play-off. All minor placings shall be decided based on a count back system.
- **10. Official practice round –** players are entitled to one free practice round on the 25<sup>th</sup> November. Tee times **must** be reserved in advance. Practice rounds outside this date will be charged at the daily rate.
- **11.Entries** close on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> November, 2019. Entry fee of AUD\$140 (inc.GST) **must** accompany Entry Form.
- **12. The Rules of Golf** The Championship will be played in accordance with the Rules of golf approved by the Royal and Ancient Golf Club of St Andrews and with the Local Rules of the Hills Golf Club approved by the Organizing Committee. Disputes, if any, will be settled by the Organizing Committee, and a decision made by the Organizing Committee will be final.
- **13. Dress regulations** It is a requirement of this tournament that all players must comply

- with the dress standards of the Hills Golf Club.
- **14.Golf Balls** The ball that the player plays must be named on the current List of Conforming Golf Balls issued by the R&A. **Penalty for breach of condition**: **Disqualification**
- **15.APJGA Membership -** Upon entering the tournament, this will automatically join the player as a member of the APJGA. There are no ongoing fees required to maintain APJGA membership. Each player will be assigned a unique APJGA membership number.
- **16. Time of starting –** Player must report to the Starter office 30 minutes prior to his/her starting time and should arrive at the starting point 10 minutes before their hitting time.
- **17. Use of motorized vehicles –** During any round of the tournament, competitors may not travel in or on any motorized vehicle unless authorized by the Committee. Penalty of 2 strokes at each hole where there was a breach with a maximum of 4 strokes per round.
- **18.Spectators (Gallery) –** Spectators are forbidden to give advice to a player during a stipulated round of the tournament. Spectators must seek permission from the Committee to use motorized carts
- **19. Suspension of Play –** When play is suspended by the Committee, if the players in a group are between the play of two holes, they must not resume play until the committee has ordered a resumption of play.
- **20. Serious breach of etiquette –** the following may be considered as a serious breach of etiquette if
  - (a) Hand phone rings or use of hand phone during a stipulated round
  - (b) Verbal abuse of fellow competitor/official/staff
  - (c) Intentionally offending a fellow competitor
  - (d) Improper behaviors such as swearing or throwing clubs
  - (e) Smoking and consuming alcoholic drinks during a stipulated round
- **21.Tournament Delays -** The Organizing Committee may, in the event of bad weather, or for any reason shorten the contest if necessary.
- **22. Measuring devices –** Laser range finders and GPS systems **can** be used during the tournament.
- **23. Publicity** APJGA arranges publicity before, during and after the tournament. It is a condition of entry that all players assent to references to them and pictures of them in practice and play being published via any medium (including the internet)
