Women 72 Hole Gross – Winner


Players may win a maximum of two trophies (exc. NTP)




Course Maps:

Players are requested to familiarise themselves with the course map to avoid any delay in commencement of play from allocated holes.

Registration:

All players are requested to report to the registration desk at least 30 minutes prior to the tee time of each round to be allocated scorecards and temporary local rules.

Withdrawals:

Any player wishing to withdraw from the championship should contact Tim Witherow on 0448 577 640 or <u>timW@golf.org.au</u>. Any entrant may withdraw and have the entrance fee refunded provided notification is received within three working days of the event. Under no circumstances will entry fees be refunded after this date unless players can provide Golf Australia supporting documents regarding their withdrawal from the event (i.e. Medical certificate).

Ready Golf:

The Championship is a "Ready Golf" event. "Ready Golf" should be played, but in a safe and responsible way. Play when you are ready – you don't have to wait until the farthest away players has played. E.g. play Ready Golf

- When the player farther away has a difficult shot and is assessing options
- When a longer hitter has to wait for the green to clear
- On the tee if a player with the honor is delayed
- By playing your shot before helping to look for a lost ball

Dress Regulations

Please visit the relevant websites of the host clubs. All players & caddies are required to adhere to the club's dress regulations.

The following are not permitted: jeans, jean-style and cargo pants, track suits, tight stretch pants for women, brief shorts, T-shirts, singlets, shirts without collars, thongs, sandals, significant advertising on any garment, hat, or shoe.

Course Care / Club Regulations

Players are reminded that sand buckets **MUST** be taken and used, and pitch marks are to be repaired. Mobile phones are not to be used in the clubhouse or on the course unless in the case of an emergency or a ruling during the round. Play will be from the nominated tee markers. Any player not complying with these requirements will be subject to action in accordance with the GA Code of Conduct.

Motorised Carts

According to GA's standard conditions of competitions, it is the responsibility of the player, if they require the use of a golf cart during the event to send a Medical Certificate and a completed copy of the Golf Australia Motorised Transport Approval Return Form for consideration by the Match Committee.

Please go to the GA website under Victorian Event Resources \rightarrow GA Motorised Transport for the return form and more information. Exemption: Players aged 75 years and over do not require a Medical Certificate.

Golf carts are at the player's own expense and MUST be booked directly through Golf Australia as soon as possible. Golf carts must be paid for at the club on the day. Golf Australia cannot guarantee the use of a golf cart on any given day of play as this is subject to each host club's conditions of usage.

Note: In the event in which a limited number of carts are available, players requesting carts will be paired together. Caddies are permitted to ride in the cart with the player ONLY when sufficient carts are available.
