TERMS OF THE COMPETITION

1. Format

- 1.1 Played over 36 holes, 18 holes each day.
- 1.2 Boys & Girls gross event for players with a GA handicap of 17.9 or less as of first day of play. Boys & Girls stableford event for players with a GA handicap of 18.0 and above as of first day of play. Handicap ranges are subject to change without notice based on entry numbers.
- 1.3 Players are to play off their GA handicap as of the first day of play.
- 1.4 In the event of a tie for first place in the gross event, unless the Match Committee determines otherwise, players in such a tie will continue play over such holes as the Match Committee will decide, in a sudden-death, hole-by-hole playoff until the winner is determined. Ties for other place-getters will be decided by countback.

2. Eligibility

- 2.1 All entrants must be under 18 years of age as at 20 January 2019.
- 2.2 Open to all boys and girls who are members of Golf Clubs affiliated with Golf Australia or overseas associations as are affiliated with or recognised by Golf Australia.
- 2.3 Maximum GA handicap for Boys (36.4) and Girls (45.4).

3. Entry Requirements

- 3.1 The entrance fee for the event is \$30.00 (including GST).
- 3.2 Entries must be made via the Golf Australia online registration system. Entries by any other method will not be accepted.
- 3.3 The decision of GA (SA) as to acceptance or refusal of any entry will be final.
- 3.4 Fully completed registrations, together with appropriate entrance fees, must be received by Golf Australia by 5:00pm (ACST) on Monday 13th January 2020. **It is the sole responsibility of the entrant to ensure that their entry has been received.** A player's registration has not officially been received until his or her name has been posted at www.golf.org.au
- 3.5 Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of GA (SA).
- 3.6 Entrance fees will only be refunded in the case of a withdrawal being advised before the draw being released on Wednesday 15th January 2020.

4. Match Committee

- 4.1 The Match Committee will comprise the GA (SA) Match Committee.
- 4.2 In the absence of the full Match Committee, such members as may be present at the time as selected by GA (SA), may give a decision, and any decision so given will be deemed to be a decision of the full Match Committee.
- 4.3 The Match Committee will have the sole management and control of the event, with full power at any time to alter or vary any one of the Terms of the Competition.
- 4.4 The Match Committee's decision on matters affecting the event will be final.
- 4.5 Any dispute or protest must be made to the Match Committee not more than 15 minutes after the conclusion of play on the day on which the disputed matter has arisen.

5. Rules of Play

- 5.1 The Rules of Golf, as adopted by R & A Rules Limited, will apply together with Local Rules of the Host Club.

6. Caddies

- 6.1 Caddies are permitted for players aged 13 years of age and under as at the first day of competition. Caddies are not permitted for players aged 14 years and above as of the first day of competition.

7. Drug Testing

- 7.1 All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Anti-Doping Agency for banned substances as laid down in Golf Australia's Anti-Doping Policy. Any competitor infringing this policy, or refusing to take a test, will be disqualified and subject to any sanction(s) brought down by ASADA.

8. Mobile Phones

- 8.1 Except in case of emergency, mobile phones must not be used to make or receive calls or messages when on the golf course.

9. Motorised Transport

- 9.1 Ride-on buggies will be permitted only on medical evidence from the player and by permission of the venue Club. Applications and approvals to be forwarded to Golf Australia (SA) at time of registration. Caddies are not permitted to use ride-on buggies.

10. Smoking Policy

- 10.1 Players and caddies are prohibited from smoking during a stipulated round. (Note: In addition to the more traditional forms of smoking, this policy is also considered to cover vaping and the like, etc.) Details of sanctions for a breach of this policy are contained in GA's Code of Conduct.

11. Code of Conduct

- 11.1 All entrants assent to be bound by Golf Australia's Code of Conduct. A copy of the Code is available at www.golf.org.au

12. Measuring Devices

- 12.1 A player may obtain distance only information by use of a distance-measuring device.

13. Draws

- 13.1 Competitors will be drawn in such manner as GA (SA) shall arrange. The Match Committee reserves the right to alter the draw without notice.
- 13.2 Tee times will be available at www.golf.org.au from Wednesday 15th January 2020.

14. Photography

- 14.1 By entering the event, you agree to having your photo taken of which may be published on social media for promotional purposes.

15. Database of Competitor's Details

- 15.1 The personal data contained in this entry is permanently retained by GA. This data may be utilised by GA or its sponsors for the distribution of correspondence, in both electronic and hard copy means. From time to time players may be sent entry forms, event literature, the GA e-newsletter, or marketing material by the sponsor(s) of GA events, or information about events conducted by GA approved bodies. Upon receipt by GA of a written request, a player may either have access to their details, or have their details deleted from the database.
