Rated 25<sup>th</sup> in Australia, Kooyonga is a classic traditional style course laid out on a sandy, undulating parcel of land in Adelaide's sand belt. Kooyonga has hosted five Australian Opens, nine South Australian Opens, eight National Amateur Championships and most recently in 2018, The Women's Australian Open.

### Format:

Tuesday 7 <sup>th</sup> January	18 Holes Stroke Play

### Kooyonga Junior Summer Trophy & Junior Girls Invitational:

Played in conjunction with day one of the Junior Boys & Girls Championship on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> January 2019 - 36 Holes Stroke Play.

### Registration:

All players are requested to report to the registration area prior to their tee time on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> January and Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> January. Registration will be located outside of the Pro Shop.

### Withdrawals:

Any entrant may withdraw and have the entrance fee refunded provided notification is received prior to the draw being made available on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> January 2020.

### Results & Draws:

The Round 1 & 2 draw for Monday will be made available on Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> January. A seeded draw for Round 3 will be made available following the conclusion of play on Monday. ### Practice Round:

Practice rounds are available from 1.30pm on Sunday 5<sup>th</sup> January at a cost of \$45 per registered competitor. Please make a booking by phoning The Kooyonga Golf Shop on (08) 8443 6162. Competitors must have registered for the Championship before making a practice round booking.

### Practice Facilities and Balls:

Practice facilities will be available to players only on the two days of the Championship. Entry fee includes 1 x range ball token per player, per day. Additional range balls will be available for purchase from the Golf Shop at a cost of \$4 per bucket.

### Pull Buggies:

Pull buggy hire is included in the entry fee and can be collected from the Golf Shop each day.

### Distance Measuring Devices/GPS:

Distance measuring devices are permitted for this Championship.

### Ready Golf:

The Championship is a "Ready Golf" event. "Ready Golf" should be played, but in a safe and responsible way. Play when you are ready – you don't have to wait until the farthest away players has played. E.g. play Ready Golf

- When the player farther away has a difficult shot and is assessing options
- When a longer hitter has to wait for the green to clear
- On the tee if a player with the honor is delayed
- By playing your shot before helping to look for a lost ball

#### Dress Requirements:

All players & caddies are required to adhere to the Club's dress regulations - <https://www.kooyongagolf.com.au/cms/golf/dress-code/>

#### Catering:

Players lunch (baguette and a piece of fruit) is provided each day. Players will receive a lunch voucher upon returning their scorecard. The Members Bar will also be open daily for purchases.

#### Mobile Phones:

Mobile phones may be used on the golf course during competition to access a distance measuring device application or to call for a ruling only.

#### Golf Australia Hard Card:

The Golf Australia Hard Card will be in effect throughout the Championship and will be provided to players at registration.

#### Course Care:

All clubs which host Golf Australia events kindly give up their course for the duration of the event. Hence, so that the course is left in a suitable condition once the Championship is completed, players MUST carry AND use a sand bucket and repair ALL pitch marks. Any player seen to be in breach of this request may face action under Golf Australia's Code of Conduct.
